Rules & Regulations

CONTESTANTS MUST NOT HOLD A CONTRACTED FESTIVAL TITLE AT THE SAME TIME OF COMPETITION!

- I. Ages are as of August 30, 2026
- II. Teen Contestants must be between the ages of 15-17
- III. Miss Contestants must be between the ages of 18-23
- IV. Teen & Miss Contestants must be single and have never been married, pregnant, nor had a child.
- V. Teen & Miss Contestants must be of good moral character and never been convicted of any felony.
- VI. All Contestants must be born a woman and a resident of the State of Louisiana.
- VII. Teen & Miss contestants must NOT hold any contracted Festival titles and shall NOT enter any other pageants throughout their (1 year) reign as a Harvest Festival on False River Queen.

Competition

- **Interview Competition** for Teen & Miss Contestants will be conducted starting at approximately 1:00 PM. Interviews will be conducted at the Julien Poydras Center, 500 W. Main Street, New Roads, LA 70760. Hair and makeup locations will be available in Suite 104. There will be restrooms available to change into interview attire. We ask all contestants to be ready 30 minutes prior to interview start time for check in. Interviews will consist of a panel of judges. Interview questions will consist of information given from the entry form but not limited. Judges may ask additional questions regarding the history of the Festival and/or Agriculture in Pointe Coupee Parish.
Teen Interviews will be 8 minutes, Miss Interviews will be 10 minutes. Interviews will count as 60 points of the contestant scores.
Interview attire will consist of a suit/dress suit, nude closed toe shoes and stockings.
- **Evening Competition** starts at 5:00 PM, all contestants must be checked in by 4:30pm.
Teen contestants are required to have an onstage introduction, no longer than 30 seconds and should include name and contestant number.
Miss contestants are required to have an onstage introduction, no longer than 60 seconds. Evening Competition will count as 40 points of the contestant scores.
Evening attire will consist of a long formal/Pageant Gown.

Pageant Day

1. All contestants must be checked in 30 minutes prior to their assigned interview time starting at 1:00pm.
2. All contestants must be checked in by 4:30 pm for the evening competition at the Julien Poydras Center, New Roads.
3. Door Admission: \$5, everyone must pay except contestants, 5 years and under gets in FREE.
4. Doors will open at 4:15pm for attendees.
5. A dressing area will be available for all contestants.
6. Bad sportsmanship will not be tolerated. Every contestant that competes is a winner!
7. **Contract signing** will take place **immediately following the Queen's Pageant**. All rules and regulations will be reviewed.
8. A Parent or Guardian must be present for the contract signing for the newly crowned Teen & Miss Queens.

Awards

- Teen Harvest Festival on False River Queens will receive a custom Harvest Inspired Crown, Elegant Formal Banner, Custom Harvest Festival Award, and a Bouquet of Flowers. Upon the completion and fulfillment of her contracted duties for the year, Teen Harvest Festival on False River Queen will be presented with a \$500 Scholarship.
- Miss Harvest Festival on False River Queen will receive a custom Harvest Inspired Crown and Scepter, Elegant Formal Banner, Custom designed Crown Box and Scepter Box, Custom Harvest Festival Award, a Bouquet of Flowers, & a paid Hotel stay and entry fee for the 2026 LAFF Queen of Queen's Pageant which will be held in Baton Rouge, LA on February 18-21, 2026. Upon the completion and fulfillment of her contracted duties for the year, Miss Harvest Festival on False River Queen will be presented with a \$1000 Scholarship.
- 1st, 2nd & 3rd Alternates of each division will receive a custom Harvest Festival award.

Upon Winning

The newly crowned 2026 Harvest Festival on False River Royalty are required to attend the 15th Annual Harvest Festival on False River on October 30 – November 1st, 2026 and events leading up to the Festival such as: 2026 Royalty Photoshoot, television appearances and interviews. Festival weekend activities will include Royalty Presentation, Queen's Day Activities, and appearance at the Saddlin' Up Special Needs Rodeo Sunday, November 1, 2026.
