Treasurer's Report:

Treasurer's Annual Report for 2025

Year 2025

Toledo Area Bicyclists (TAB) concluded Fiscal Year 2025 in a stable and improved financial position, reflecting steady revenue, disciplined expense management, and responsible oversight throughout the year.

Financial Snapshot (FY2025)

- **Starting Balance (January 2025): \$27,730.72**
- **Ending Balance (December 2025): \$33,514.60**
- **Net Increase for the Year: \$5,783.88**

TAB ended the year with a positive increase in overall funds, strengthening reserves while maintaining flexibility for future programming and advocacy efforts.

Revenue Overview (2025 Activity Only)

Membership dues continued to serve as TAB's primary and most reliable revenue source.

- **Membership Revenue: \$6,345.30**
- Additional revenue included banquet receipts, cash memberships, and other minor deposits.
- **Total Deposits for 2025: \$14,567.45**
- **Total Expenses for 2025: \$8,783.57**

Membership revenue followed expected seasonal patterns, with stronger inflows earlier in the year and steady support throughout the riding season.

Expenses and Stewardship

Expenses were managed carefully and aligned with TAB's mission, including:

- Support for rides, programs, and events
- Advocacy and safety initiatives
- Routine administrative and operating costs

No extraordinary or unexpected expenses materially impacted the budget.

Year-End Position

TAB ends 2025:

- Financially stable and stronger than at the start of the year



- With no outstanding liabilities of concern
- Well positioned to support programming, advocacy, and member services in 2026

The year-end balance provides appropriate reserves while allowing flexibility for future initiatives.
