



Executive Board Meeting: Thursday, February 5th @ 6:30PM

Location: Danberry Realtors Training Room, 355 Briarfield Blvd, Maumee, OH

The meeting was called to order at 6:30PM. The minutes for the previous board meeting were approved.

#### **Treasurer's Report:**

- Annual Report for 2025 was reviewed. Starting Ballance: \$33,514.60; Ending Ballance: \$34,326.15
  - Net Increase for the Year: \$811.55
- Membership is 63% collected based on last years total collection.
- See full Treasurer's report for full details

#### **Membership/RunSignUp:**

- Some members are getting membership expiry notifications even after renewing in January.
- Email distribution does not have as wide of a reach as in previous months
- Website is not that extensive as other organizations using runsignup.
  - Amanda offered to explore cost of widgets needed to enhance the website.

#### **SideCut Seven:**

- Kris proposed 2 routes, shared with Nicole
  - Parallel to construction 25.5 miles
  - South increases route to about 28 miles
- Eric and Kris working together to identify 2-3 options to trial and propose to the membership.
  - Options will include the routes previously proposed by Eric
  - Plan to use Ride Leader & Pace Line Training events to test (will have approximately 6-weeks)
- Group discussed possibility of having a group of routes that could be rolled through during the season
  - Pros: seemed to work well for the Windsday Ride last year
  - Cons: could cause confusion with riders and ride leaders
  - Will approach the membership for feedback

#### **Weeknight Rides:**

- SpokeLife wants to collaborate a ride with the club out of their now Fallen Timbers location.
  - Suggestion was made to target Tuesday's since there is already an established ride in Elmore.
  - Would require Shannon's Tuesday Ride to relocate start locations to Fallen Timbers
- Chuck is confirming Ride Leaders for the 2026 season.

#### **Kit Updates:**

- Storefront is now live and ready to go.
  - Will remain open as long as we would like it to.
- Credit assigned will be communicated to Voler and distributed that way.
- Approaching CycleWerks and SpokeLife about sizing nights so that others can try the kits also.
- Email will be sent to membership with kit design to help build excitement; will push in March



### **New Business:**

- Facebook Presence
  - Outside organization posts to the Group are pushing club communications out of direct view
  - Need to identify who is the Admin/Moderator of the TAB Facebook PAGE
    - Current board does not have access to the PAGE, only the GROUP
  - Jodie will try to identify who the Admin/Moderator is and see if we can be granted access to begin utilizing it as a resource again.
- Ride Leader Training
  - Ride Leader Training is scheduled for Thursday, February 19th @6:30p Walbridge Park Shelterhouse
    - Purpose of Ride Leader Meeting has a disconnect between the hosts & membership.
    - Need to clarify ahead of the event who is invited and asked to attend
    - Training element needs to be clearly communicated in the advertising
  - League of American Bicyclists have a training offering April 11th, should we identify someone to attend and become a trainer for the club?
    - Jodie will investigate details and prerequisites required.
  - Eric, Jodie, Sizanne, & Crissy all expressed interest in supporting Ride Leader Training & Rider Clinics as part of the 2026 season.

### Treasurer's Report – February 2026

Toledo Area Bicyclists (TAB) started 2026 in a strong and stable financial position, reflecting steady revenue, decreased insurance costs, and steady membership dues collection.

#### Financial Snapshot (Year-to-Date, 02/05/26)

Starting Balance (January 1, 2026): \$33,514.60  
Ending Balance (February 5, 2026): \$34,326.15  
Net Increase Year-to-Date: \$811.55

#### Revenue Overview (Year-to-Date)

Membership dues continued to serve as TAB's primary and most reliable revenue source.

Membership Dues Revenue Year to Date: \$3,991.29

(Membership Dues is roughly 63% collected based on last year's total collection of \$6,345.30).

Total Deposits Year to Date: \$4,581.29

Total Expenses Year to Date: \$3,779.74

Insurance

Director & Officers Liability \$600.00

Accident Coverage \$2,640.96



Insurance savings of just over \$500 from last year.

Banquet netted just over \$200 in revenue this year.

### **Year to Date Position**

TAB begins 2026:

- Financially stable and stronger at the start of the year.
- In strong financial position for coming months with insurance already paid, banquet gaining revenue, and 1/3 of expected membership dues not yet paid.
- Well positioned to support programming, advocacy, and member services in 2026.
