Deming Edges Andrejczyk To Score Second Consecutive Roxbury Victory

ROXBURY – The longest race this season almost became photo finish for the title.

Chris Deming held on to win the winged-foot trophy and added to a season point total that puts him in an enviable position after 11 races to garner his third season title at the weekly Roxbury Road Runners Club series.

Deming, 59, of Danbury outran Mark Andrejczyk to win the 8.5-mile race that included a trip up inclines on Painter Hill Road and Booth Road that resembled the slopes at Powder Ridge.

Deming was clocked in 1:02.38.35. Andrejczyk, 53, from Shelton crossed the timing carpet in 1:02.41.

Deming had captured a 4.3-mile event on May 9. He now has annexed 536 points for the season, well ahead of Patrick McGuire, 37, of Derby, who has 420 points.

In the women's division, Miriam Acevedo made it a weekend double.

A night earlier she was the first female in 40-49-year old category at the New Milford Moonlight Run 5K. She was timed in 22:58.

On Saturday, May 16, she placed first in women's standings at Roxbury, finishing 12th overall with a 1:15.25 clocking. It was her fifth victory of 2026 in the women's division.

Acevedo, 49, of New Milford won the female season standings at Roxbury in 2025. She is again leading this campaign with 390 points.

The Roxbury Mile I is slated for Saturday, May 23, 8:30 a.m. The course goes from near the intersection of Apple Lane and Rocky Mountain Road to the parking lot at the Booth Free School.

Runners should arrive early and check in at the Everett B. Hurlburt Community Park pavilion so that they are logged into the computer system.

Current and former military personnel, current and former first responders and youth entrants should inquire about discount fees. The general charge is \$45 for a season pass and \$10 for the weekly waiver.

The races, which are sanctioned by the Roxbury Recreation Commission, start and finish near the community park at 18 Apple Lane.
