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## Abraham Collects Seventh Consecutive Win; Constatine Takes Female Crown

ROXBURY – The last time someone other than Wylden Abraham took first place was before the calendar formally turned to summer.

Since June 20, Abraham, 17, of Roxbury has reeled off seven consecutive victories at the weekly Roxbury Road Runners Club series.

His most recent triumph came over a 4.2-mile loop that was run for the first time in the series.

He was clocked in 28-minutes, 04.64-seconds – a 6:41-per-mile pace - on Saturday, August 15, just weeks before he becomes a student-athlete at Gettysburg College.

Michael Reeves, 14, of Brookfield placed second on the layout, which included a trip along Wellers Bridge Road and up and down Hemlock Road. He was timed in 28:21.

Kaleigh Constatine, 29, of Southbury was the first female finisher and placed ninth overall in 33:14.

She placed third in the 2025 women's season standings at Roxbury

Constatine ran at Danbury High School and for a year at Iona University. She transferred to the University of Connecticut of Storrs, where she did not compete in cross-country of track & field.

Constatine, a psycho-therapist, trains about 30 miles a week.

The field of 51 finishers included several members of the 169 Towns Society – the runners that attempt to complete a race in each of Connecticut's municipalities.

The series will continue on Saturday, August 22, 8:30 a.m., with a 7.2-mile event, which will include a trip up the hills on Mallory Road.

The races, which are sanctioned by the Roxbury Recreation Commission, start and finish near the Everett B. Hurlburt community Park at 18 Apple Lane.

Runners should arrive early and check in so that they are logged into the computer system.

Current and former military personnel, current and former first responders and youth entrants should inquire about discount fees. The general charge is \$45 for a season pass and \$10 for the weekly waiver.

During August, the runners are collecting pre-owned running shoes for Sneakers4Good.

The Roxbury Fall Classic, which included a 50-kilometer race, marathon and half-marathon, is scheduled for Saturday, November 14. Registration is available at <https://runsignup.com/Race/CT/Roxbury/RoxburyMarathonHalfMarathonand50k>.

The ninth annual Roxbury Thanksgiving Day Charity Race is slated for Thursday, November 26, 9 a.m., over a 3.1-mile route.

The fee is \$10 plus a \$1.60 handling charge – for a grand total of \$11.60. Race-day registration of \$15 per runner – plus a \$1.90 handling fee for a grand total of \$16.90 - - will be available November 26 at the pavilion to the community park from 7:30 to 8:50 a.m.
