INDIANA SPORTS CORP CORPORATE CHALLENGE EVENT RULES – BUCKET GOLF

- Each company will be permitted to enter one (1) team of four (4) employees (a full team must consist of at least one gender identifications i.e., Male, Female, Non-Binary).
- If you have less than three (3) participants, you may still compete; however, you will not receive a score for each missing participant. Team members must compete one at a time.
- Game Rules
 - Every hole in BucketGolf is a par 3.
 - Hitting any part of the bucket counts as scoring to end the hole. (not the flag stick)
 - **Chipping your ball inside the bucket counts as scoring to end the hole and subtracts 1 stroke off your score on the hole.**
 - If you hit your ball into any hazard (foilage, water, street, etc) you must take a drop no closer to the hole than where it went out and 1 stroke penalty.
 - The player with the lowest score at the end wins!
 - Note: House rules always apply so feel free to add any extra rules you like to increase the fun.
- All teams must start at the same time starting at hole 1
- Play will start in Best Ball format and will switch to Scramble format later in the round.
 - **Best Ball bucket golf rules:**
 - Everyone throws independently until their own ball goes in the bucket.

- **Scramble bucket golf rules:**
 - Everyone throws/rolls/kicks (whatever house rule is) from the tee.
 - The team picks the best throw.
 - Everyone throws again from that spot.
 - Repeat until a ball lands in the bucket.
- Teams will compete against other divisions on site (first come first serve)
- Scoring will be division break down
- Scoring scale to convert to points (lowest score wins the bucket; tie split points)
 - 1 throw to bucket: 10 points
 - 2 throws to bucket: 8 points
 - 3 throws to bucket: 6 points
 - 4 throws to bucket: 4 points
 - 5 throws to bucket: 2 points
 - 6+ throws to bucket: 1 point
- Clubs and balls will be provided onsite
Participants CANNOT use their own clubs or balls.
