EVENT RULES - NON-COMPETITIVE SCORING

- Participants in the Cycling Time Trial, 5K Run, and 10K Team Run who do not score competitive points for their company may still earn participation points.
 - Participation points are awarded based on the Participation Events scoring scale:
 - o Division 1 - 10 points per participant
 - o Division 2 - 8 points per participant
 - o Division 3 - 6 points per participant
 - o Division 4 - 6 points per participant
- Every participant must be properly registered and wear the required event bib and timing chip to receive participation points.
- Cycling Time Trial: A company may enter an unlimited number of cyclists. Only the top five (5) finishing cyclists, with at least two gender identifications (Male, Female, Non-Binary), score competitive points. All additional eligible finishers may earn participation points.
 - 10K Team Run: A company may enter an unlimited number of runners. Only the first four (4) team finishers, with at least two gender identifications (Male, Female, Non-Binary), count toward the competitive team score. All additional eligible finishers may earn participation points.
 - 5K Run: A company may enter an unlimited number of runners. Only the team's top male/non-binary and top female/non-binary finisher in each age group score competitive points. All other eligible company finishers may earn participation points.
 - Friends and family may register for the 5K or 10K through the designated Friends & Family registration option, but they do not earn company participation or competitive points and must sign the required event waiver.

NOTE: Participation points earned through non-competitive Cycling, 5K, and 10K finishers count toward the overall Participation Events category, which has a maximum of 400 points per company.
