PARKING

PARKING

There is plenty of parking for Packet Pickup and Race Day on campus. Available parking includes Campus Safety Parking, Stadium Deck Parking, and the Wright Street Parking Deck, but **not allowed in Arena Parking Lot between Auburn Arena and Jordan-Hare Stadium.**



SPECTATORS

Spectators can enter and exit the Stadium via Gate 8 which is on the East side of Jordan-Hare Stadium. Spectators will not be allowed onto the field but are allowed to occupy the lower sections of the stadium seating. Please be respectful of the stadium and do not enter the upper sections of seating. We ask that you self manage your trash utilizing the trash cans throughout the venue.

COURSE MAP - WAR EAGLE 5K



SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 28

START TIME: 7:30am

START LOCATION: Heisman Drive between Jordan-Hare Stadium and Campus Green

FINISH LOCATION: 50 Yard Line of Jordan-Hare Stadium

The start line for the 5K presented by Glenda Mitchell Law Firm will be outside Jordan-Hare Stadium. Runners will self-seed in corrals based on expected finish times. The race will start at 7:30am in a wave start fashion. 150-200 runners will be allowed to start approximately every 30 seconds.

*All 5K runners MUST maintain a running pace of 29:00 min/mile. If runners are not able to hold this pace, they will be picked up by Race SAG vehicles and moved ahead on the course or brought to the finish line. Our event permits require the courses be reopened on this schedule. No race services: aid stations, police supervision, and medical assistance will be available beyond this pace.

**All courses are very well marked. There are mile markers for each distance event, directional signs for course splits and TURNAROUND signs for course turnarounds. Course splits and course turnarounds will be manned with an operations staff member who will typically be making announcements on a megaphone. Course turns are indicated with traffic cones and usually (not always) have police units, volunteers and/or staff members. Traffic on courses is managed by our law enforcement partners, but no roads are promised to be closed to all traffic. Runners should be aware of their surroundings: the course, applicable signage, vehicles, staff, volunteers, and police officers.

What is included with the War Eagle Kids Mile registration?

- ATHLETE bib with electronic timing chip
- PARENT bib to be worn by the parent/guardian responsible for checking the child out after the race
- Event T-Shirt (youth sizing available)
- Finisher Medal at the finish line for kid (parents do not receive a medal)
- Post-Race Party Food and Beverage tickets

Is there an age limit? The War Eagle Kids Mile is for children 12 years old and under. Kids 12+ should register for the 5K. (Both distances are friendly to walking and race staff attends a "half-mile" turnaround on the War Eagle Kids Mile to let the little kids get to the finish line quicker if they like.)

Can parents run with their children? Yes, but we encourage you to let them run on their own. The course is closely monitored and secured by race officials and local police.

Finish Line & Kid Checkout: Only race personnel and kids participating in the race will be allowed in the finish chute and checkout areas. You may enter Jordan-Hare Stadium through the East Stadium gates after your kid starts the race. Once you see your child in the finish chute, you can show your **PARENT** bib to the attendant to claim your child. If you have multiple kids, you will need to show your **PARENT** bib for each child in order for them to be released. If a parent runs with their child, please wear the **PARENT** bib.

If you do not have the **PARENT** bib that matches the **CHILD** bib, the attendant will verify the information on the back of the **CHILD** bib with your photo ID. If you don't have a photo ID, you will be directed to one of our police partners to claim your child.





SUNDAY, MARCH 1

START TIME: 7:00am

START LOCATION: Heisman Drive between Jordan-Hare Stadium and Campus Green

FINISH LOCATION: 50 Yard Line of Jordan-Hare Stadium

The start line for the Half Marathon will be outside Jordan-Hare Stadium. Runners will self-seed in corrals based on expected finish times. The Half Marathon will start at 7:00am in a wave start fashion. 150-200 runners will be allowed to start approximately every 30 seconds.

Aid stations will be every 1-1.5 miles along the course and gel will be provided at one aid station on the route. Once those details are finalized the map will be updated to reflect this information.

*All Half Marathon runners MUST maintain a running pace of 18:20 min/mile. If runners are not able to hold this pace, they will be picked up by Race SAG vehicles and moved ahead on the course or brought to the finish line. Our event permits require the course be reopened on this schedule. No race services: aid stations, police supervision, and medical assistance will be available beyond this pace.

**All courses are very well marked. There are mile markers for each distance event, directional signs for course splits and TURNAROUND signs for course turnarounds. Course splits and course turnarounds will be manned with an operations staff member who will typically be making announcements on a megaphone. Course turns are indicated with traffic cones and usually (not always) have police units, volunteers and/or staff members. PHOTOGRAPHY TIPS

Did you know that you will receive FREE digital photography at all FRESHJUNKIE Racing events? Want to make the best possible photos? Follow these simple tips for great pics!

- **Clearly display your bib number at all times.** This means having it on the center of your torso on your outermost garment. It doesn't help if it's under a sweatshirt, on your back, or on your leg.
- Look up. Keep an eye out for our Official Race Photographers. They will be on course and at the Finish Line capturing images of you.
- Thumbs up, arms above your head, peace signs, V for victory...whatever it is, have fun!
- Most importantly, **Smile!**

(Remember you paid to do this!)



COURSE SAFETY

AID STATIONS AND EMS

Medical personnel will be stationed at each aid station along the race course to monitor and treat any athlete who is injured or in distress. Aid stations also offer water, Powerade, and portable toilet facilities. Local EMS will also be providing medical support throughout the race course.

MEDICAL SUPPORT

Each medical tent will be staffed with teams of medical professionals and equipped with emergency equipment and supplies. The Main Medical Tent is located just past the Finish Line.

MEDAL ENGRAVING

Participants who prepaid for Medal Engraving will need to bring their race bib and finisher medal to the "Medal Engraving" tent located in the finish area. Receipt printers are available to ensure we spell your name and engrave your finish time correctly. Medal engraving takes 2-3 minutes. If there is a line you can leave it with our staff. Be sure to come back to claim it later as we will not ship unclaimed medals after the event is over.

Medal engraving may also be purchased on race day for \$20, pending availability and wait times at the engraving tent.

MAIL MY BIB - SWAG PICK UP

Participants who paid to have their bib mailed to them will be able to claim their SWAG (event shirt, bag, etc.) after they complete the race. Follow the signs to **"PACKET PICKUP"** once you finish the race and present your race bib to the staff there, they will provide your SWAG and mark the back of your bib.

You are welcome to come to any of the pre-race packet pickups to claim your SWAG if you like. Present your race bib and the staff will provide your items to you.

Bibs are mailed via USPS two weeks prior to race day. They are sent to the SHIPPING ADDRESS provided when you registered. If you paid to have your bib mailed and never received it, please report to a Pre-Race Packet Pickup and a staff member will be able to rectify the situation.

GEAR CHECK

There will be a Gear Check located near the start line. If you bring a bag, clearly marked with your BIB NUMBER, you can drop your personal effects at the truck just before the race starts. Please allow some time for us to get the bags organized and ready to be checked out. We expect Gear Check bags to be available by 8:30 am. and will close at 11:30 am. We are not responsible for the items placed in Gear Check.

BIBS & FOOD/BEVERAGE TICKETS

We do our best to ensure there is adequate sustenance for participants. Please understand that food and drinks are for event participants only. Encourage any friends or family coming to spectate to pack some snacks and drinks for themselves. All participants will have **FOOD/BEVERAGE TICKETS** attached to their race bib. Do not remove these. A staff member or volunteer will collect a ticket when you pick up a food or beverage item in the post-race party area.



TIMING AND RESULTS

RESULTS

Results will be posted on our website immediately following the race on the RESULTS page of www.WarEagleRunFest.com.

Want to find your results as soon as possible? Scan the QR code on signs around the venue to jump right to the results. Remember to select the distance/event that you participated in under the 'Result Set' dropdown.

AWARDS

In addition to Finisher Medals awarded to each finisher in each race, there will be specific overall, masters, grand masters, great grand masters, and age group awards for the Half Marathon and 5K. Overall and Age Group award winners will each receive a custom award medal engraved with the award description: 1st Place Female, Age Group 40-44 as an example. Overall award winners will ALSO receive a custom, laser-engraved slate award to commemorate their finish.

Awards categories can be found on the **AWARDS** page of our website. Awards for the 5K will be available starting at 8:30am. Awards for the Half Marathon will be available starting at 9:30am. Awards will not be issued until they are verified by our timers. Awards are not shipped post-race and must be claimed at the event. There is no award ceremony.

All awards must be picked up at the event. When registering, you can elect to have your results sent via text message or email to your phone. These are sent within minutes of you finishing the race. Results can also be checked at our TIMING AND RESULTS tent near the finish line. 5K Awards can be claimed AFTER 8:30am from the AWARDS Tent. HALF Marathon Awards can be claimed AFTER 9:30am from the AWARDS Tent. The Award ceremony will take place at 10:00am and will announce OVERALL winners only. Awards will not be shipped post-race automatically. If you need your award shipped, you can purchase that option from our store for up to 2 weeks post-race. [CLICK HERE FOR THE STORE LINK](#).

Runners who finish the War Eagle 5K on Saturday **AND** finish the War Eagle Half Marathon on Sunday receive the coveted Weagle Weagle Challenge Award. For the 2026 event, the Weagle Weagle Award will be a custom challenge medal that slides onto the ribbon of your Half Marathon medal and transforms into a wearable belt buckle. 


