RACE DAY INFORMATION

Bib & Swag Pickup

We encourage you to pick up your bib & swag prior to race day. Space will be very limited in the building on race morning, and the number of people inside will be restricted. Traffic flow will be one-way – please enter through the back of the building, and exit quickly through the front of the building when you are finished.

Start Time

Mistletoe Mile begins at **8:00 AM**. Frosty 5 begins at **8:30 AM**. Please allow plenty of time on race morning – we will not be able to accommodate late starters.

Cutoff Time

Participants still on course at 9:45 AM will be moved to the sidewalks.

Bib Assignment

Bibs must be worn by the participant who is registered and was assigned the bib.

How to Wear Your Bib

Please wear your bib in front, visible, and horizontal to assure we get a good chip read for you. Keep away from metal (zippers) and electronics (gps watches and smartphones).

Drops

If at any time you decide not to continue, please notify a WRR staff member. If a participant drops, their result will show through the last timing point completed. Participants who drop are responsible for their own transportation back to their car.

Restrooms

Porta-potties will be located near Destination Hudson/Hudson Visitors Center.

Frosty Tees

Frosty triblend (\$15) and Brooks tech tees (\$20) will be available for purchase on race day at Vertical Runner Hudson after the race (cash only, please).

Santa

Santa will join us at the start/finish line. Be sure to say “hi” and take a photo with him!

Santa’s Helper Awards

“Santa’s Helper” awards will be given to the first three participants finishing the race in festive holiday attire. Gift certificates will be provided by Vertical Runner.

Frosty 5 Mile Awards

Course Map

Participants are encouraged to review the course map. Frosty 5 is a road race through Downtown Hudson. Be aware of weather conditions and watch for ice and slippery surfaces.

The course is marked with coroplast signs/turn arrows and cones. Course marshals will also guide you on course.

There will be water stops at mile 1.75 and mile 3.75. Participants are also encouraged to carry water.

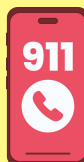
