Vendor Application Process

Applications must be submitted by the October 11 deadline. Vendor space is not confirmed until this application is signed by Edwin Gianini. Scan and submit via email to edwin@laurenmccluskey.org

Waiting List

Applicants who did not receive a space assignment will be placed on a waiting list. If you are placed on the waiting list this will be communicated to you by email. The event planning team will do everything we can to accommodate as many groups as possible but space is limited.

Space Assignments, Set-up and Take-down

You will be assigned your space by the Race Director upon arrival, with setup available on 10/16/2026 from 5 to 8 PM or on 10/17/2026 from 6 to 7:30 AM. The event space will be monitored by trained security overnight. Spaces may be reassigned if you have not arrived and set up by 7:30 AM on October 17. All spaces must be staffed from 8 AM to 12 PM on 10/17/2026. Before departing, please ensure all belongings are collected and your space is fully broken down, including tables, equipment, and canopy. Trash bins and bags will be available for use.

Cancellation of Space

Booth and space fee will be non-refundable. If application form is denied, the fee will be refunded.

Parking

There is free parking available at the event parking lot for one (1) vehicle per group, which can be used for unloading and may remain on site throughout the event. Please note that vehicles cannot exit between 9 AM and 12 PM without approval from the Race Director, as the parking lot entrance, exit, and access road are part of the 1K, 5K, and 10K course(s).
