PARKING OPTIONS

There's lot of parking in downtown Knoxville - but we suggest the options below for ease:

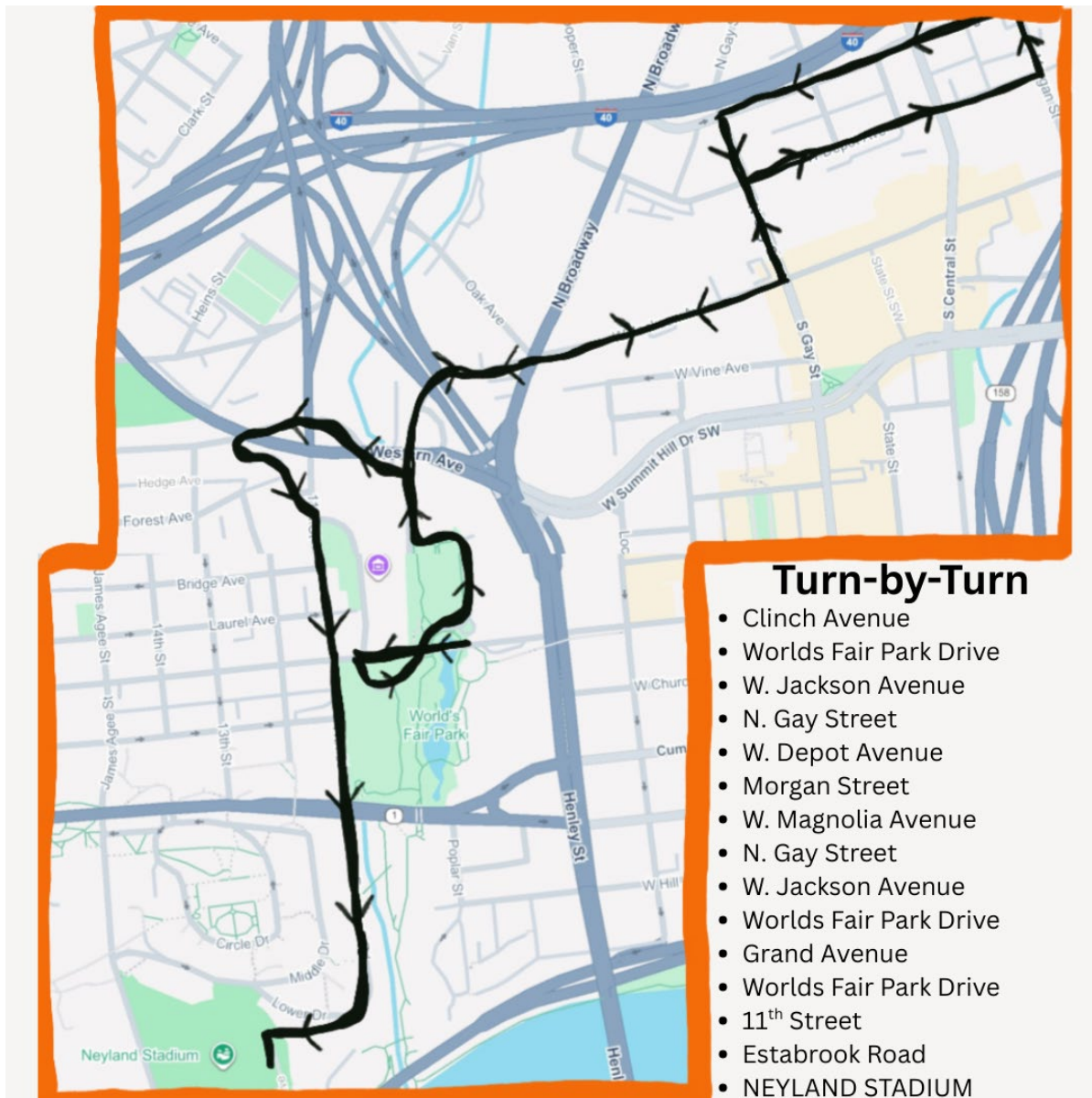
Parking for Participants:

- G-10 Parking Garage (1271 Neyland Drive) - this will require a short walk to the starting line, but your car will be close by once you finish.
- 11th Street Garage (1101 Cumberland Ave) - this is the closest to the start line, but will require a short walk back after you finish.

Parking for Spectators:

- We recommend parking in the G-10 Parking Garage - this gives you the closest access to cheer on your family and friends as they Finish on the Field!

FINISH LINE/POST-RACE/STADIUM INFO

We've created a graphic below to help you familiarize yourself with our stadium finish.

Spectators can enter via Gate 2 on the east side of the stadium. We ask that you make your way to Sections A, B, C, D, or E to watch. Participants will finish near the 20 yard line, near Sections A and B, proceed south to Section D, and enter the stands from there. To help with congestion at the finish line, we'll have backdrops and photo opportunities in the blue highlighted areas. This will give your support crew an opportunity to join you as you show off your new commemorative
