RACE INFORMATION

Bib & Swag Pickup

- Bib & swag pickup begins at 5:00 PM at Pine Hollow.
- Series participants will turn in their bibs at the end of the race to be re-used for the remainder of the series.
- Series hoodies will be distributed at weeks 3 & 4.
- Series finisher medals and awards will be distributed at week 5.

Headlamps

Sunset is at 7:11 PM. You may need a headlamp — keep in mind it gets dark earlier in the woods.

Start Time & Cutoff Time

Start time is 6:15 PM. Cutoff time is 7:45 PM, based on a 23 minute/mile pace rounded up to the nearest 10 minutes. Anyone not on pace to finish by this time accepts the responsibility to know the course and complete it without any support.

Mid-Race Drops

If at any time you decide not to continue, please notify a WRR staff member. Participants who drop are responsible for their own transportation back to their car.

Bib Assignment

Bibs must be worn by the registered participant who was assigned the bib. Please wear your bib in front, visible, and horizontal to assure we get a good chip read for you. Keep away from metal (zippers) and electronics (gps watches and smartphones).

Results

Results will be posted/available live – scan the QR code on your bib.

Restrooms

Porta-potties will be located at the start line.

Theme

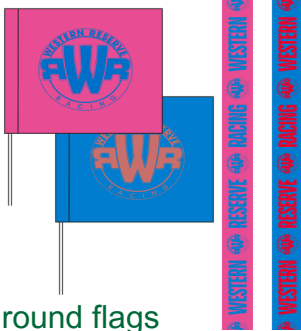
The 2026 Fall Running Series theme is **Carnival Games**.

Course

The Week 1 course at Pine Hollow will be 3.8 miles.

Course Markings

All course marking materials are WRR branded. These include alternating pink & blue ground flags and streamers, coroplast signs, and cones.



A course marker will be found about every 0.1 mile. After turns, there will be a sequence of 3-4 ground flags and/or streamers in the trees as confidence markers.

Off Course

If you go off course, you must backtrack/return to the correct path by your own means. You must start from the point where you went off course.

The RaceJoy app provides the ability to be sure you are on course as well as tracking capability.

Watch for slippery surfaces such as wooden steps and bridges.

AID STATIONS

Fluid Station

There will be a fluid station on course about halfway through. Participants are also encouraged to carry water.

Finish Line

A variety of sweet and salty snacks will be provided at the finish line.
