River Grove Picnic Area North Chagrin Reservation 2944 River Rd, Willoughby Hills, OH 44094 Park at River Grove, Old River Farm (sledding hill), or the overflow lot at Squires Castle (3/4 mi walk along bridle trail to the start)

RACE DAY INFORMATION

Start Time Dirty Dirty 15k begins at 9:00 AM.

Cutoff Time Participants must finish the race by 12:00 PM (3 hour cutoff). To stay on pace, the first loop should be completed in 1.5 hours. Anyone who continues past this time accepts the responsibility to know the course and complete it without any support.

How to Wear Your Bib Please wear your bib in front, visible, and horizontal to assure we get a good chip read for you. Keep away from metal (zippers) and electronics (gps watches and smartphones).

Drops If at any time you decide not to continue, please notify a WRR staff member. If a participant drops, their result will show through the last timing point completed. Participants who drop are responsible for their own transportation back to their car.

Restrooms There are 4 total restrooms in 2 locations at the start line. Cleveland Metroparks does not allow porta potties to be brought in.

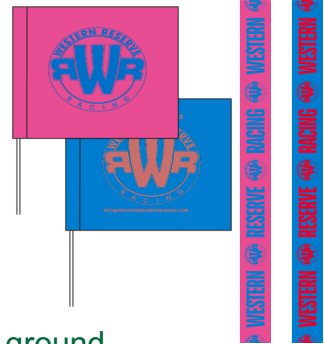
COURSE INFORMATION

Course Map Participants are encouraged to review the course map. Dirty Dirty 15k is a two-loop course. Participants must cross the finish line at the completion of each loop to get split times. Watch for slippery surfaces such as wooden steps and bridges.

COURSE MAP

Bridle Trails This event will be on shared trails, with horses having the right of way. If you approach a horse, slow to a walk and step to the side of the trail, announce yourself, and ask the rider for permission to pass. Move and speak calmly and slowly so the horse isn't startled.

Course Markings All course marking materials are WRR branded. These include alternating pink & blue ground flags, coroplast signs, & streamers.



A course marker will be found about every 0.1 mile. At turns, there will be a sequence of 3-4 ground flags and/or streamers in the trees as confidence markers.

The RaceJoy app provides the ability to be sure you are on course as well as tracking capability.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Spectators Spectators are welcome at the start/finish line—invite your friends and family. Please ask them to park in the overflow lot at Squires Castle.

Volunteers Spectators are welcome to join us as volunteers and earn credits!

RULES

No Pacers: You cannot be accompanied on the course by anyone who is not a registered participant.

Aid: Participants cannot accept any aid from anyone (crew, family, friend, Elvis impersonator, moving vehicle, bicycle) beyond 100 feet of an Aid Station. Absolutely no littering! You may not stash supplies along the course.

Off Course: If you go off course, you must backtrack/return to the correct path by your own means. You must start from the point where you went off course.

Bibs: Bibs must be worn by the participant who is registered and was assigned the bib.

AID STATIONS

Table with 4 columns: MILE, LOCATION, TYPE, OFFERING. Rows include aid stations at 2.2, 4.8, 7, and 15K Finish miles.

\*Participants are encouraged to carry water
