

This is Let Me Run

Let Me Run is a nonprofit wellness program that inspires elementary and middle school-aged boys to **be themselves**, be active, and belong!

With a comprehensive curriculum that applies the **power of running**, Let Me Run programming encourages boys to develop their psychological, emotional, and social health, in addition to their physical health.

Twice a week for seven weeks, trained volunteer coaches lead a team through practice. Designed to **amplify confidence**, self-expression, and respect for others, each practice includes a lesson from the Let Me Run curriculum that incorporates running, games, and activities.

Each fall and spring season culminates in a 5K race festival that celebrates the boys' **success and personal growth!**



Since its inception in 2014, Let Me Run has served over **2,300 boys** and enlisted more than **500 volunteers** in the Central Ohio (Columbus) Region. Since Fall 2021*, **123 teams** have participated with more than **1,400 boys**. Our end-of-season Spring 5K welcomes **750-850 runners and spectators**.

About **20%** of Let Me Run participants in the Central Ohio Region require financial assistance. Sponsors, donors, and friends like you ensure Let Me Run programming is accessible and affordable for all boys who wish to participate.

Let Me Run Works!

Knowing the numbers aren't always in our boys' favor, Let Me Run seeks to break down **negative societal pressures** and **unhealthy male stereotypes** that can lead to often life-threatening consequences.

An independent evaluation showed participation in Let Me Run:

- Enhanced participants' ability to express emotions, show affection, **build friendships**, and connect with others
- **Improved boys' attitudes** and behaviors associated with healthy masculinity
- Increased boys' levels of **vigorous physical activity**
- **Reduced boys' screen time** on programming days
