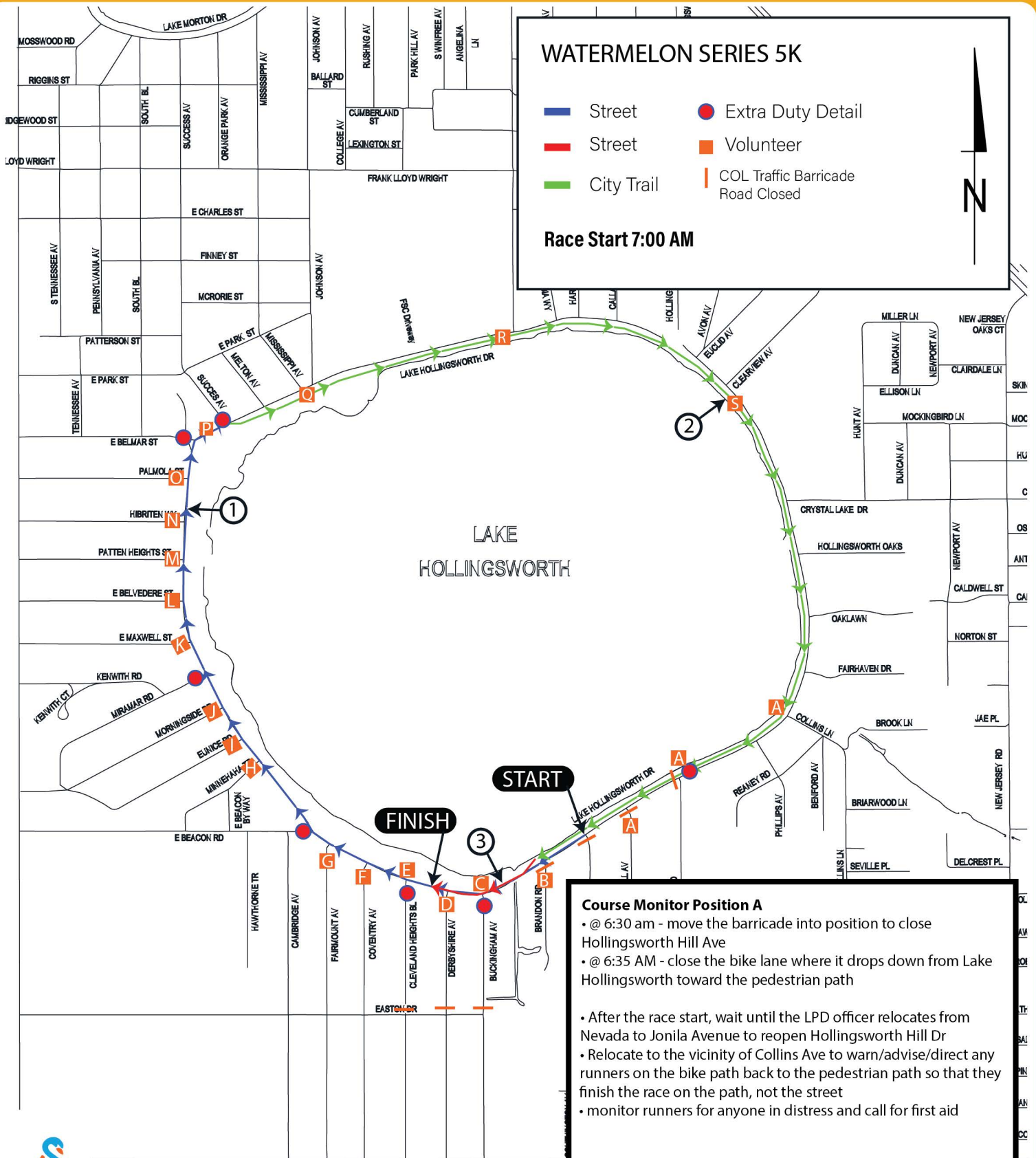
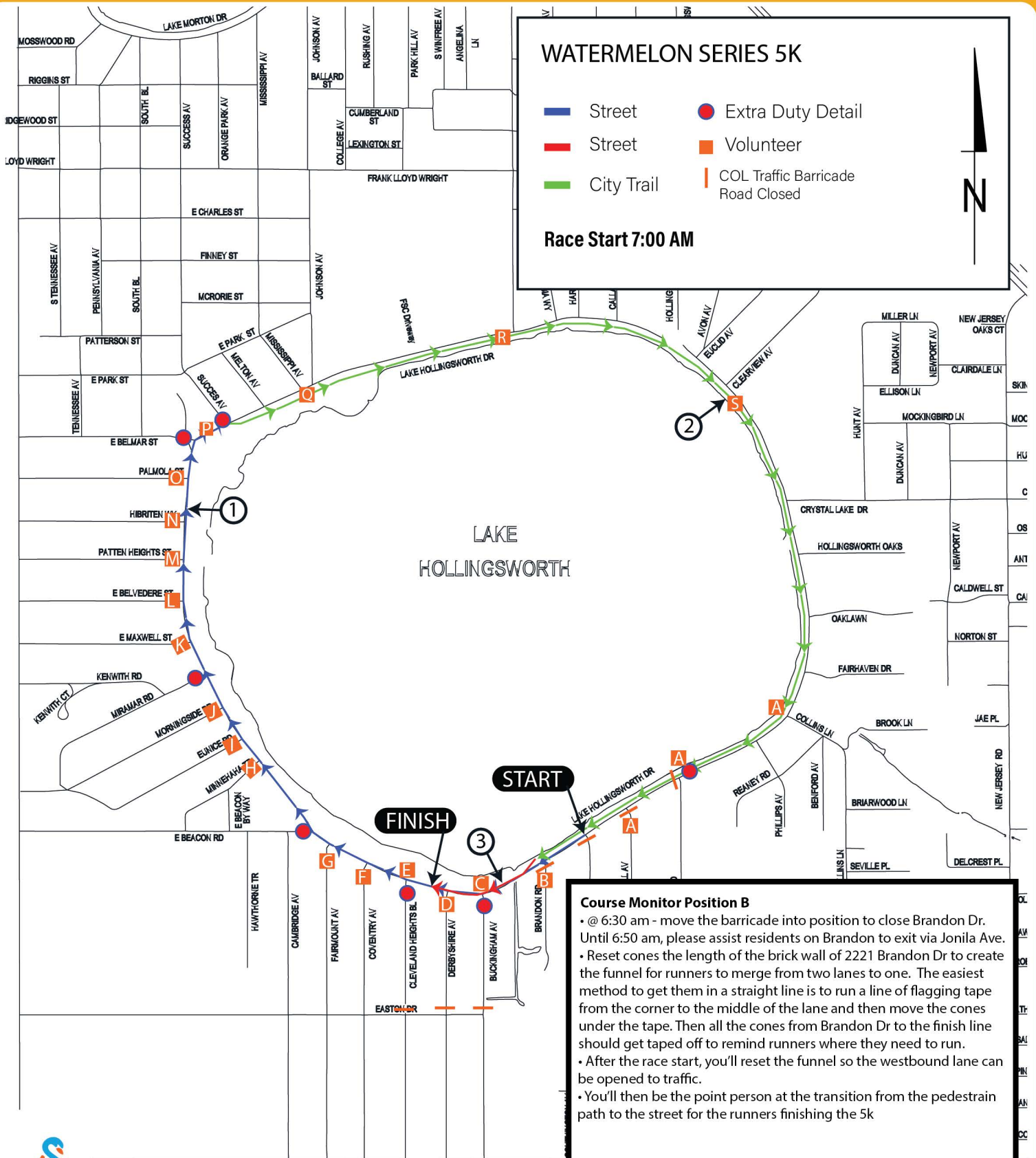

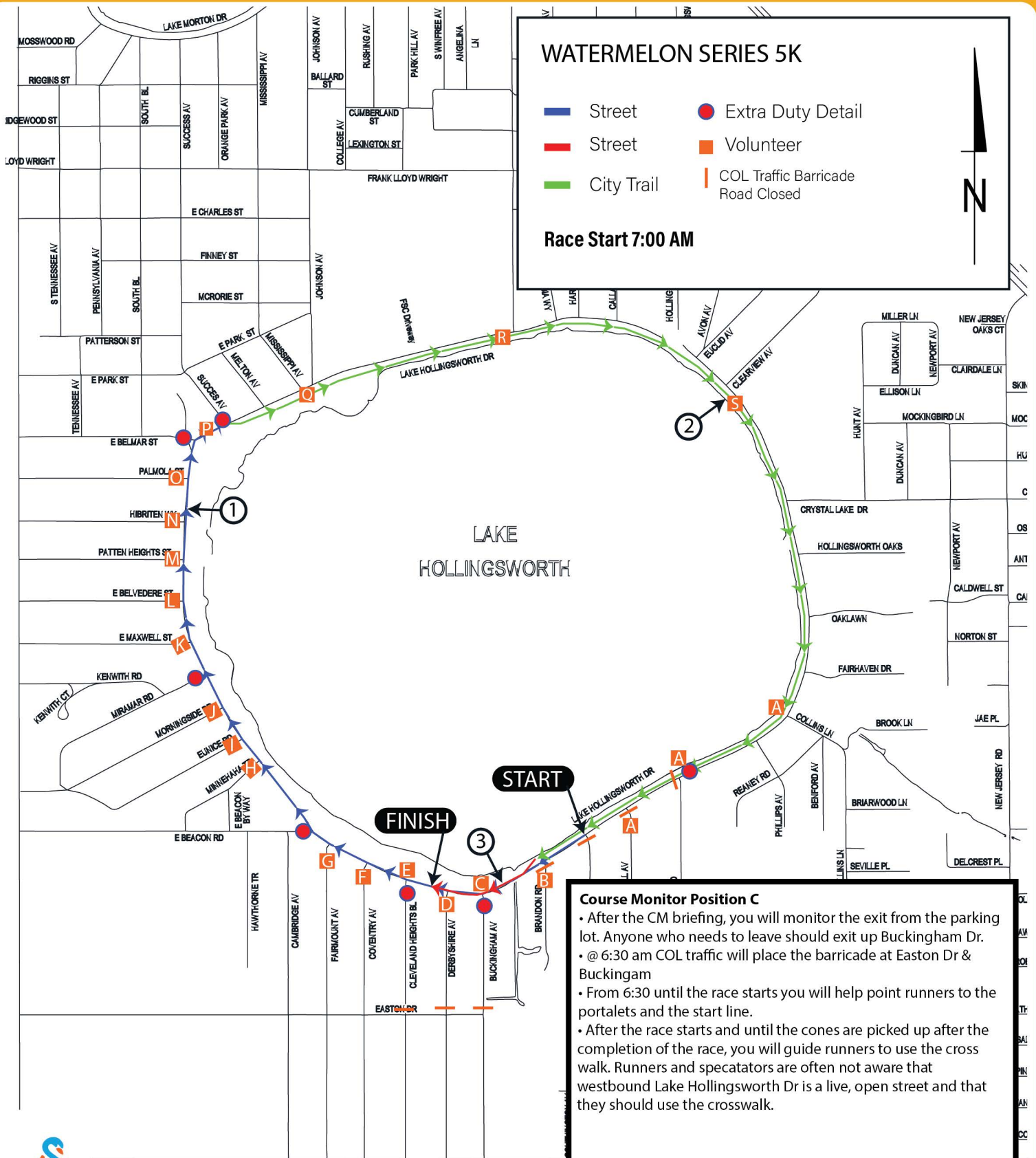
**Race Start 7:00 AM**

**Course Monitor Position B**

- @ 6:30 am - move the barricade into position to close Brandon Dr. Until 6:50 am, please assist residents on Brandon to exit via Jonila Ave.
- Reset cones the length of the brick wall of 2221 Brandon Dr to create the funnel for runners to merge from two lanes to one. The easiest method to get them in a straight line is to run a line of flagging tape from the corner to the middle of the lane and then move the cones under the tape. Then all the cones from Brandon Dr to the finish line should get taped off to remind runners where they need to run.
- After the race start, you'll reset the funnel so the westbound lane can be opened to traffic.
- You'll then be the point person at the transition from the pedestrian path to the street for the runners finishing the 5k

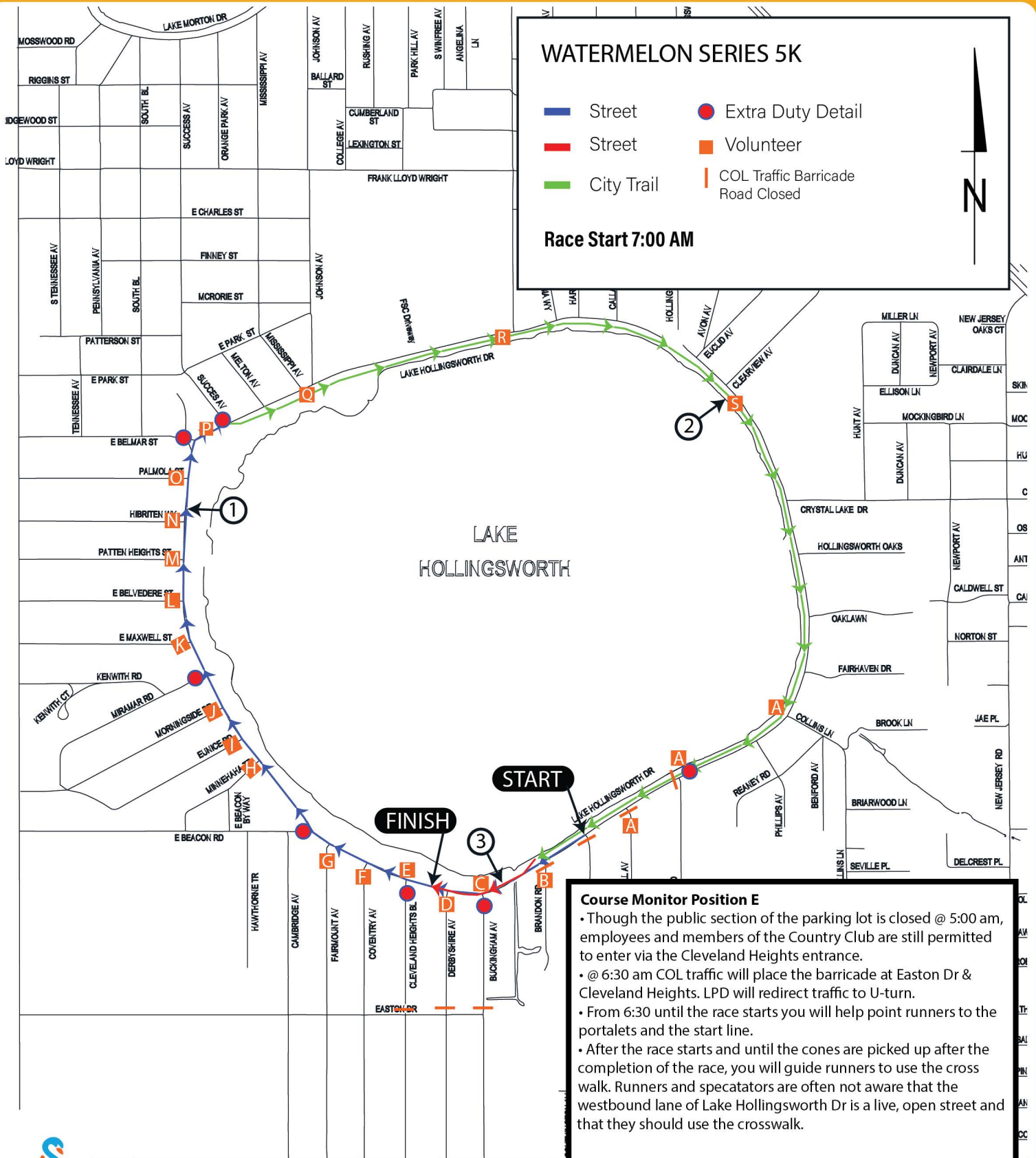
### Course Monitor Position C

- After the CM briefing, you will monitor the exit from the parking lot. Anyone who needs to leave should exit up Buckingham Dr.
- @ 6:30 am COL traffic will place the barricade at Easton Dr & Buckingham
- From 6:30 until the race starts you will help point runners to the portalets and the start line.
- After the race starts and until the cones are picked up after the completion of the race, you will guide runners to use the cross walk. Runners and spectators are often not aware that westbound Lake Hollingsworth Dr is a live, open street and that they should use the crosswalk.

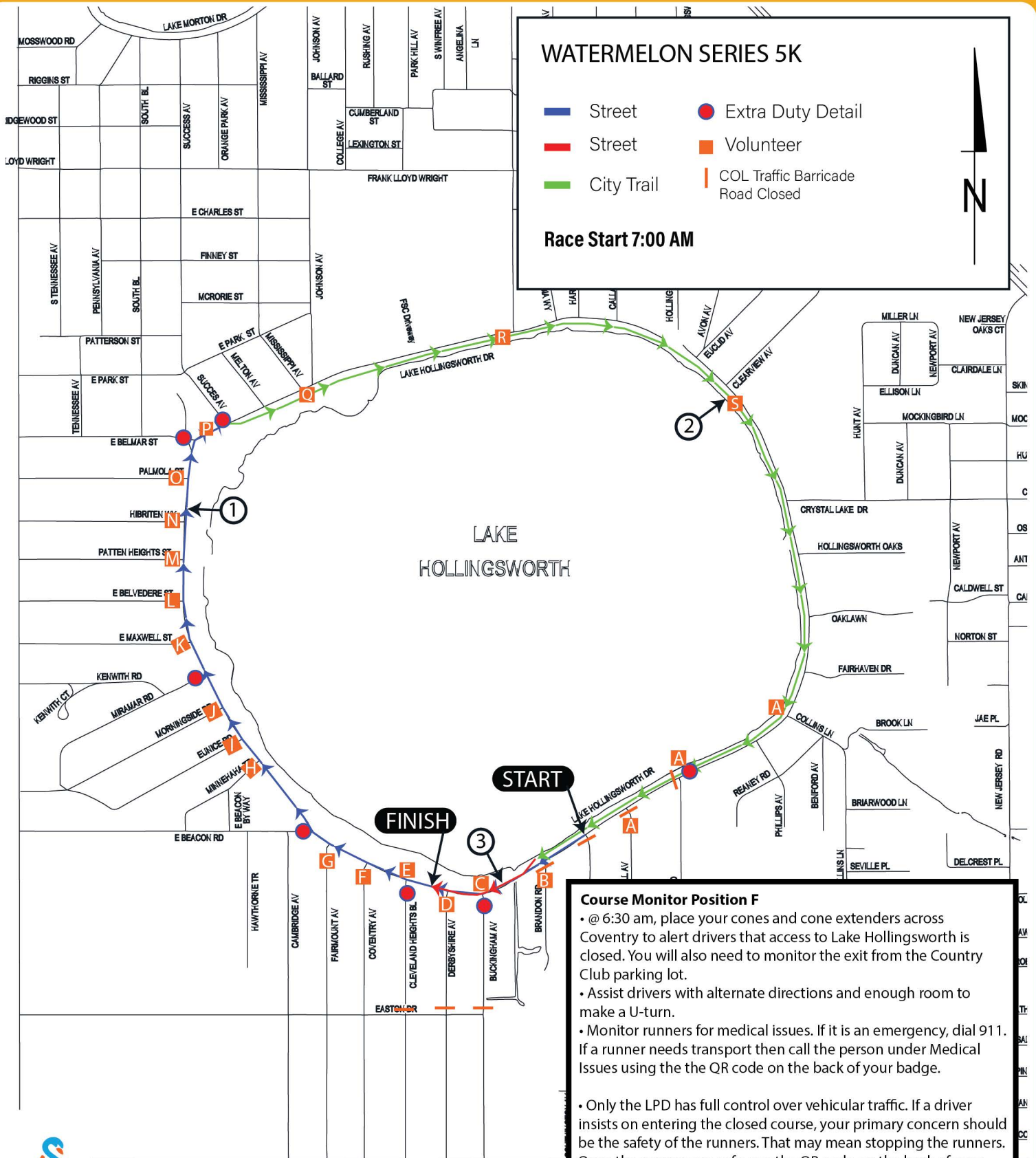




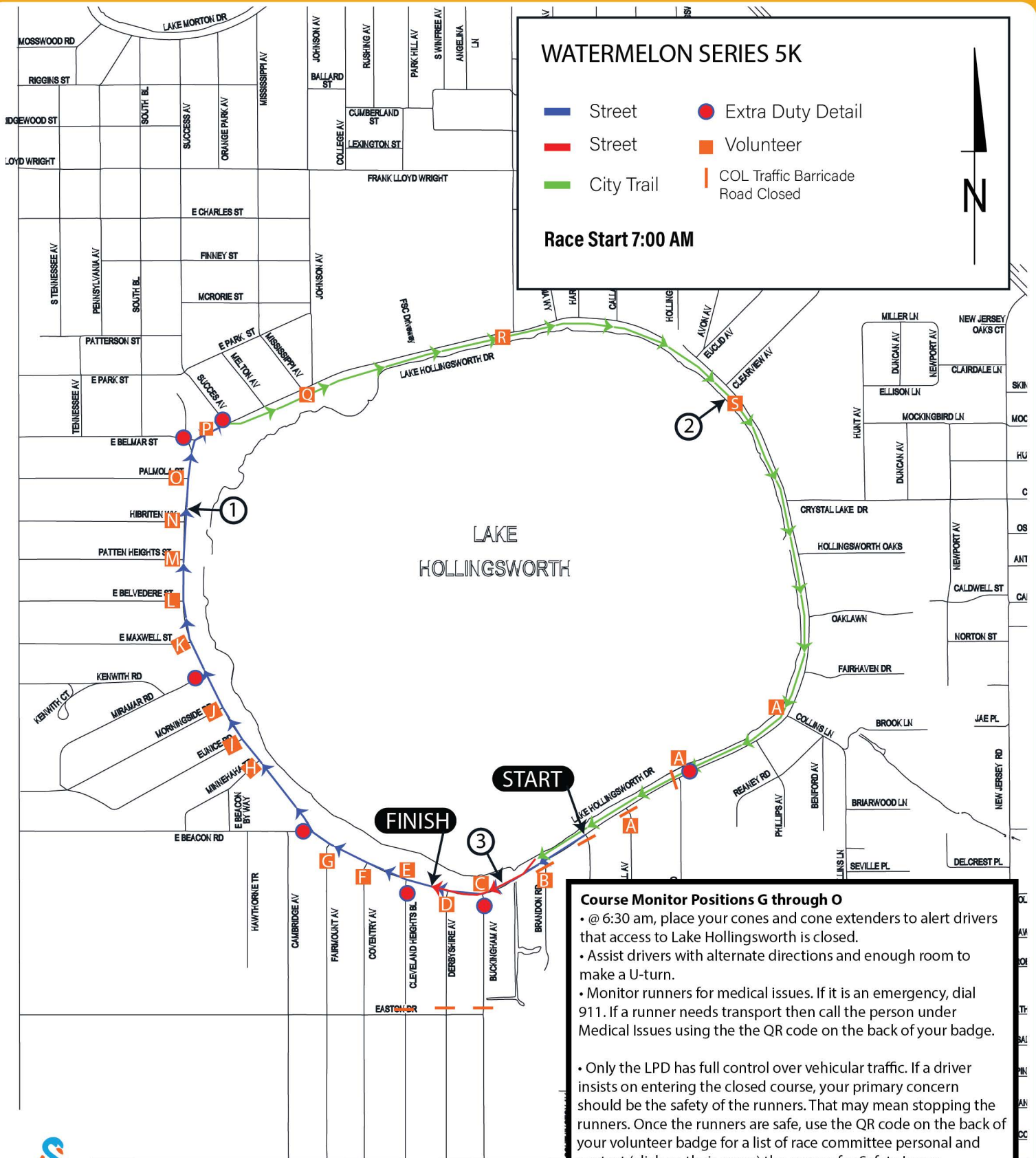
