- 1:00 to 4:00 PM – Kody & Herren take the stage
- 2:30 & 4:15 PM – Bus Transportation back to East Aurora – To help us with planning you must sign up ahead of time through the registration system. Please go to your Givesignup.com account to add the transportation option by 9/28 if you did not sign up during your initial purchase.

PARKING AT THE START - EAST AURORA

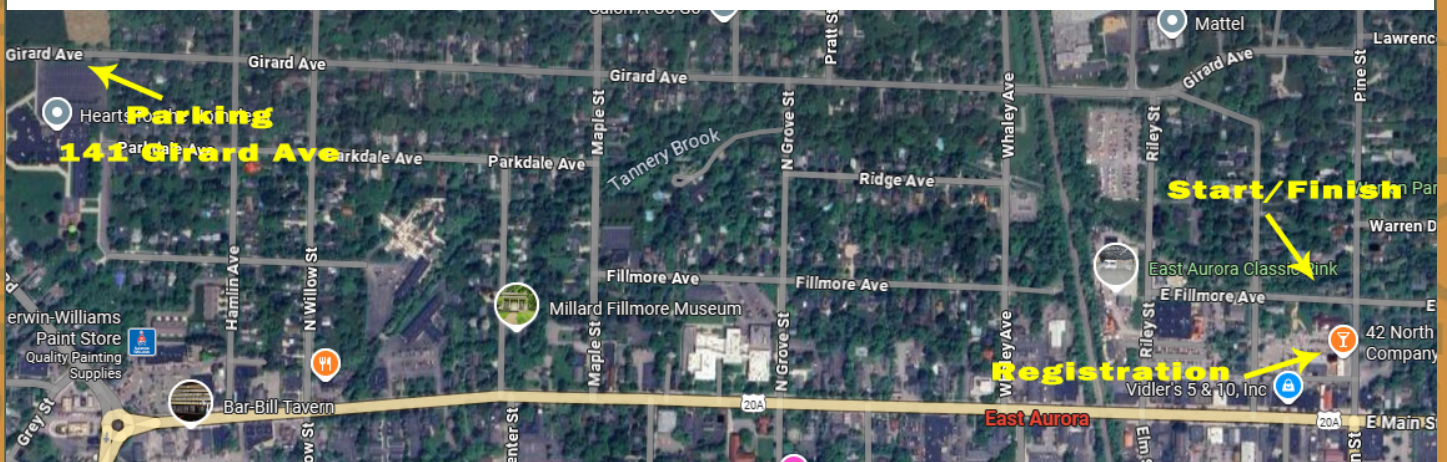
VERY IMPORTANT!

NEW PARKING LOCATION FOR 2025

Due to the East Aurora Farmers market being moved to the Riley St. Parking lot, we have had to move our participant parking for 2025.

For this year we have arranged parking at the Parkdale Elementary School – 141 Girard Ave. The parking lot is a mile from our start location on Fillmore Ave. We will have a bag check to bring at registration so you will not have to return to your car after packet pickup. We will make sure that your items get to the finish line at Holiday Valley Resort.

We ask everyone to utilize the Parkdale lot on Girard Ave. and not in the other public or private lots around the Village of East Aurora. In order to hold the start in East Aurora we had to assure the Village officials that our participants would all use the Parkdale Parking lot. Thank you for your understanding and compliance with this request as we may not be able to hold the event in future years if we do not follow this request.



PARKING AT THE FINISH - HOLIDAY VALLEY

There is plenty of parking at Holiday Valley Resort if you would like to leave a car for the ride back to East Aurora. Please park in the upper lot of Holiday Valley indicated by the shaded area on the map. We ask that you do not park in the No Parking area as that is where we will have the finish line and after-party set up.



PACKET PICKUP / BAG CHECK

Packet pickup is inside 42 North Brewing at 25 Pine St., East Aurora from 8:00 AM to 9:45 AM. Riders will receive their ride numbers, fundraising premiums such as t-shirt or jersey, as well as food & drink tickets for the after-ride party. Restrooms will be available inside 42 North Brewing.

There will also be a bag check at packet pickup if you would like to get a change of clothes to the finish line. Look for bag pickup after you finish near the entrance to the party.

COURSE

Our 42 mile course from East Aurora to Ellicottville runs parallel to the proposed trail. Look for the signs in a few spots that point out future site of the trail.

VERY, VERY IMPORTANT!

The course is open to traffic and riders must obey ALL traffic laws. Please obey all stop signs, traffic lights, and stay to the right on the road. Please ride single file and avoid riding two abreast on narrow sections of roadway. Riders must obey the rules of road and pay attention to traffic right of ways.

If riding in a group, don't attempt to stop traffic for the group, please wait until traffic is clear as our permits with the State, County, and local municipalities for the event depend on everyone obeying the traffic laws.

Every turn on the course will be marked with orange arrows and directional signs. We will have volunteers at key intersections to act as course pointers. The course pointers are there to make sure riders are going the correct direction and they will not be directing or stopping traffic. Fortunately, our course is lightly traveled and has very few turns but we want to make sure everyone remains safe.

TECHNICAL SUPPORT

Helmet use is mandatory for the ride. Please be sure you have a helmet that fits properly before ride day.

There will be tech support on the course provided by Tom's Pro Bike. Tom's will have mechanics at the start to provide minor last-minute repairs and will have vehicles on course if you develop a mechanical issue. Please check your bike well ahead of the ride to make sure it is in good working order; don't wait until the day before the ride. Tom's Pro Bike has locations around the Buffalo area to service your bike. Please see their website for locations and contact information: www.tomsprobike.com.

If you are having a mechanical issue during the ride, please mention it to a volunteer at a water stop or call 716-222-0265 if you are not near a stop and we will send a mechanic from Tom's. Please keep this number with you as it can be used if you have any issues during the ride.

WATER STOPS

The ride will have three water stops stocked with sports drink, energy snacks, and water as well as restrooms at the following locations:

- Colden Town Hall (8812 State Rd., Colden) – Mile 11.5
- Land Pro Equipment (336 Vaughn St., Springville) – Mile 21.9 ****NEW LOCATION FOR 2025**
- Ashford Community Center – Mile 30.5

AFTER-RIDE PARTY

The after party starts at 1 PM with the band Kody & Herren taking the stage. For riders that reached the minimum fundraising goal of \$100, food and drink tickets for one food item and one 42 North beer will be distributed at packet pickup in East Aurora. The party is open to everyone, so bring your friends and family. The more the merrier! Food and drink tickets can be purchased on site at the party.

TRANSPORTATION BACK TO EAST AURORA

If you purchased the ride back to East Aurora from Ellicottville we have arranged for bus transportation to leave at 2:30 PM and 4:15 PM. Look for the bus and signs right near the finish line. Your bike will be sent in a van following the bus protected by furniture blankets. To help us with planning you must sign up ahead of time through the registration system.
