

START ORDER

In order to ensure you run or walk with participants of your own pace, you should self seed yourself based on your anticipated race pace. Faster runners to the front, joggers in the middle, walkers and strollers towards the rear.

START LINE

Sub 20 min to 25:00 5K Time 25:01 to 30:00 5K Time 30:01 to 35:00 5K Time 35:01 to 40:00 5K Time 40:01 and Above 5K Time





NO PETS ALLOWED.

Service animals specifically trained to aid person with a disability under the ADA (American Disabilities Act) are permitted.



When you check-in you will receive a white envelope. Your envelope will have your name on it and inside the envelope will be your bib number, timing chip and two orange twist ties. You will need to use the twist ties to attach the timing chip to one of your shoes (see photo sequence below). Please DO NOT attach the chip to your shoe with your shoes laces as this can break the chip and cause you to not receive a time.

The timing chips are reusable. We will be collecting them at the end of the race.



Your shoe chip will serve as your "ticket" at the end of the race to receive a medal.

We want to ensure that only registered and participating individuals receive a medal.

Results / Gun Time / Chip Time?

This event will be chip timed. Two times will be provided in the results. A "Chip Time" and a "Gun Time".

Chip Time - Is your actual time and starts when you cross the mat at the start and ends when you cross the mat at the finish.

Gun Time - Is calculated when the horn/gun sounds at the start of the race and ends when you cross the finish mat.

We will be using gun time to score and assign your finish position. If you want to be considered for any awards you should position yourself as close to the front of the starting group as possible. This complies with

USATF Rule 245.3 - regarding transponder timing - "the actual time elapsed between an athlete reaching the starting line and finish line can be made known to the athlete, but will not be considered as official time. In short, official time per USATF rule is gun time."







Awards

We have a lot of awards to go through.

Here are the awards categories



- Top 3 Overall Male and Female (6 awards)*
- Top 3 Overall Male and Female Age Group (54 awards)
- 10 and Under, 11-14, 15-19, 20-29, 30-39, 40-49,50-59, 60-69, 70+

*Overall winners will also qualify for an age group award.

**Please help us speed up awards by ensuring your information is correct. Check you GENDER (yes many people register with the wrong gender). Check the spelling of your name and age. Much of the information is contained on the label with your bib and chip.

Awards will not be mailed to anyone not present. Stick around to ensure you go home with your awards.



All finishers will receive a 15th Year Commemorative finishers medal. When you finish the race, turn in your timing chip at the registration tents for a medal.

Q: Can I pickup race packets for family/friends?

A: Yes you can but please bring their confirmation email with you.

Q: I am coming from out of town, will there be race day pickup?

A: Yes, race day pickup will start at 8:00 a.m.

Q: How long is the Little Pumpkin Dasher Kids Race?

A: The first event, for kids aged 4 and under is approximately 100 yards long while the second event for the kids aged 5 and older the distance is approximately 200 yards.

Q: Where can I park?

A. There are numerous public parking lots available in the Historic Uptown District. In addition you can park on the street at the designated parking spaces.

Q. How early should I arrive?

A. We recommend arriving at 8:00 am for two reasons.

1) Soak in the energy of the morning and 2) This will ensure you arrive in time for the start as road closures will begin to close down at 8:30 am. You will have to walk a lot further to the event.

Q: My shoe chip number does not have a number or has a number that does not match my bib number?A: Shoe chip numbers and bib numbers do not need to match your bib. Just make sure you have the correct envelope. The envelope has your name on it.

Q. Can I place my shoe chip in my pocket or on my bib number?

A. No, the shoe tag must be properly and securely placed on your shoe.

Q: What do I do with my shoe chip at the end of the race?

A: Your shoe tag is your "ticket" to receive a medal at the end of the race. When you finish you will turn in your shoe tag and will receive a finishers medal. No Shoe Tag = No Medal.
