Fearless Fighter Foundation was started in October of 2021 after Krista and Ed Fink's son Dylan battled a rare form of stage 4 non-Hodgkin's Lymphoma. Dylan is now back living the life of a normal teenager at Stow HS playing lacrosse as a starter on Varsity for the school and will continue his lacrosse career at Malone University.

Our mission is to provide funding for advanced pediatric cancer research as well as provide support to families who are currently battling pediatric cancer.

In September of 2020, our son Dylan was diagnosed with a rare form of stage 4 non-Hodgkin's lymphoma. He had cancer present in the lymph nodes in his neck, collar bones, chest, spine, spleen, and at the base of his skull.

Dylan went through 6 rounds of high-intense chemotherapy from September, 2020 to March of 2021. In April he was declared in remission and on May 4th he was able to ring the bell, signifying the end of his treatment.
