### **ABOUT PRRF**

#### **Our Mission**

The Pediatric Retinal Research Foundation's (PRRF) mission is to raise awareness of pediatric retinal diseases, drive research, and support the community of affected individuals and their families. We do this by funding relevant research to understand, treat and prevent pediatric retinal diseases including retinopathy of prematurity (ROP), persistent fetal vasculature syndrome (PFVS), retinoschisis, Coat's disease, Norrie disease, familial exudative vitreoretinopathy (FEVR), and Stickler syndromes.

#### **Our Research**

Each year, we continue our investment in research initiatives at the Oakland University (OU) Pediatric Retinal Research Lab (PRRL). We support initiatives that will spark a discovery and bring us closer to a cure for one of the seven diseases PRRF supports. In 2024, PRRF invested in five (5) pilot grants that provide investigators with the initial resources needed to generate preliminary research data. As we expand our research initiatives, we know this will open new opportunities for drug developments and therapies for children with vision loss.

Additionally, PRRF donated to the SUPER Student program at the OU Eye Research Institute allowing summer undergraduate students to learn how to do eye research in the PRRL. It's important to expose students to the research field to not only recruit researchers, but to also give future clinicians a better understanding of how both fields work closely together to find treatments and cures for patients.

#### **Connecting Families**

PRRF continues to see growth each year in our community outreach initiatives. We are continuously looking to provide answers to critical questions, as well as highlight trends and innovative opportunities on the horizon - all at no cost to families, caregivers, children and supporters. We hosted our annual Family Connection Conference in April 2025 and continue to launch Through Our Eyes podcast episodes twice monthly with the goal of helping young adults and families navigating life with vision loss. We also recently launched our revamped website with tons of new resources and updated information.



## STEP 2: PERSONALIZE YOUR PAGE

#### **Personalize Your Fundraising Page**

• Visit www.HopeforVisionWalk.org and login to your account (top right corner).



- If you registered as a Team, you'll see TWO options under "Fundraising." The first option should have your name (your individual fundraising page) and the second option should have your TEAM name (your team page). You can edit BOTH pages.
- If you registered as an individual participant, you'll see ONE option.






### STEP 2: PERSONALIZE YOUR PAGE, CONT.

- Click on "Edit Fundraiser" to edit your individual AND/OR team page.
- Your team page will be seen by supporters who want to give to the entire team instead of one individual, as well as people who want to join your team.
- On your "Edit Fundraiser" individual page, you can update your name, goal, showing the thermometer & donor list, your URL, heading, photo, and display message.
- In the Personal Message to Display, you can add multiple photos, bold fonts, font colors, links and more!
- DON'T FORGET TO CLICK "SAVE FUNDRAISER CHANGES" AT THE BOTTOM!






# STEP 2: PERSONALIZE YOUR PAGE, CONT.

- After saving changes to your personal page, click on "Back to Fundraisers" then click on "Edit Fundraiser" for your team page (if applicable).
- Similar to your personal fundraising page, you can edit the team name, goal, if you want the thermometer or donor list to show, edit the URL, upload an image and edit the text that displays on your team page.
- ALSO, you can add additional team captains at the bottom for those who are serving as a co-captain of your team!
- DON'T FORGET TO CLICK "SAVE FUNDRAISER CHANGES" AT THE BOTTOM!




# STEP 2: PERSONALIZE YOUR PAGE, CONT.

• While logged in to your profile, click on your TEAM page URL



- At the top of your TEAM fundraising page, you'll see a JOIN button. Send your team URL link to your friends, family and colleagues and encourage them to join your team by hitting the JOIN button right from your page.
- Then, when logged into your profile, you'll see the "View Roster" link (above). Click on that link to see who has joined your team.
- Lastly, when you click on your TEAM fundraising page URL, you'll see the "Tell your story, add a slideshow" button. Click here to add up to 10 photos to your team page (in addition to what you add in the message body of your page.





## STEP 3: START FUNDRAISING

#### **Spread The Word**

When you're logged in to the HopeforVisionWalk.org page/profile, scroll down to see your custom fundraising page(s) URL link. Copy your personal fundraising page OR team page URL to share electronically!

- Share your web link on your social media pages with a specific ask for donations
- Share your web link in an email to friends, family, co-workers, community group members, place of worship members, school friends

#### How To Raise \$500 in 1 Week:

Day 1: Sponsor yourself with a \$25 donation

Day 2: Ask 4 family members to sponsor you for \$25

Day 3: Ask 7 friends to contribute \$20

Day 4: Ask 5 neighbors to sponsor you for \$15 (or Facebook friends)

Day 5: Ask 6 co-workers to contribute \$10 (or community group members)

Day 6: Ask 2 businesses you frequent for \$25 (doctor, dentist, accountant, etc.)

Day 7: Ask your boss for a company contribution of \$50

#### Ideas To Create Your "Ask" List

Want to know the secret of huge fundraising success? It's asking the people you know to give. It really is that simple. But many people are afraid to ask and end up saying "no" for their contacts.

## STEP 4: THANK YOUR DONORS

- When logged in to your HopeforVisionWalk.org profile, under "Edit Fundraiser" you'll see "View Donations."
- Click on "View Donations" to see who donated to your page/team.
- You can download a CSV to mail merge, save, etc. to send thank you's to your donors.
- This process is the same for your TEAM fundraising page just click "View Donations" by your team page to see who donated to the team overall.
- All donors will automatically receive a tax receipt/thank you email from PRRF.
