





A LETTER FROM THE FOUNDER

Dear Community Partner,

We are excited to announce that the **fourth annual** Capital City Race, in Memory of Jared Palmer, will take place on Saturday, **May 9**, **2026**, at the Missouri State Capitol in Jefferson City, Missouri. This race serves as a powerful platform to promote community and support mental health awareness and recovery efforts.

Featuring **5K**, **10K**, and Jefferson City's *first and only* **half marathon courses**, this event serves as a powerful platform to promote the community, mental health awareness, and recovery support in town and across our state.

The heart of this race lies in the friendship between Matt Chinn and Jared Palmer, fraternity brothers from the University of Missouri. During college, Jared began facing growing mental health challenges. Despite the care and encouragement of those around him, he continued to struggle—an experience that profoundly impacted Matt and inspired his lifelong commitment to helping others fighting similar battles.

Matt's own journey has been one of redemption and purpose. A former high school wrestling standout and coach, his life unraveled after college due to substance misuse and multiple DWIs, costing him his dream job as head wrestling coach at Helias Catholic High School. After his fourth DWI, Matt reached rock bottom. While sobering up in jail, he prayed for help—and saw the words "Everything happens for a reason. God is with you" written beneath his bunk. That message became the turning point in his life.

The next day, Matt entered treatment at Valley Hope in Boonville, MO, completed recovery, and graduated from the Cole County Treatment Court program. He rebuilt his life, reopened his business, and began using his story to inspire hope in others.

Tragically, Jared passed away in November 2021 after his battle with mental illness. In his memory, Matt founded the Capital City Race in 2023, fulfilling a promise to create an event that unites people, raises awareness, and inspires hope.
