- **10:00am:** Snowman Dash (100 meters) **Start** **This is a 100 meter dash for kids!*
- **10:05am:** WinterFest 5K (presented by Jim Charrette of State Farm) **Start** **We ask that walkers please start in the back*
- **11:00 am:** 5K age group + overall awards will be presented at the start/finish line with raffle winners being drawn after the 5K start with raffle winners names being placed on baskets by 10:30am. 😊

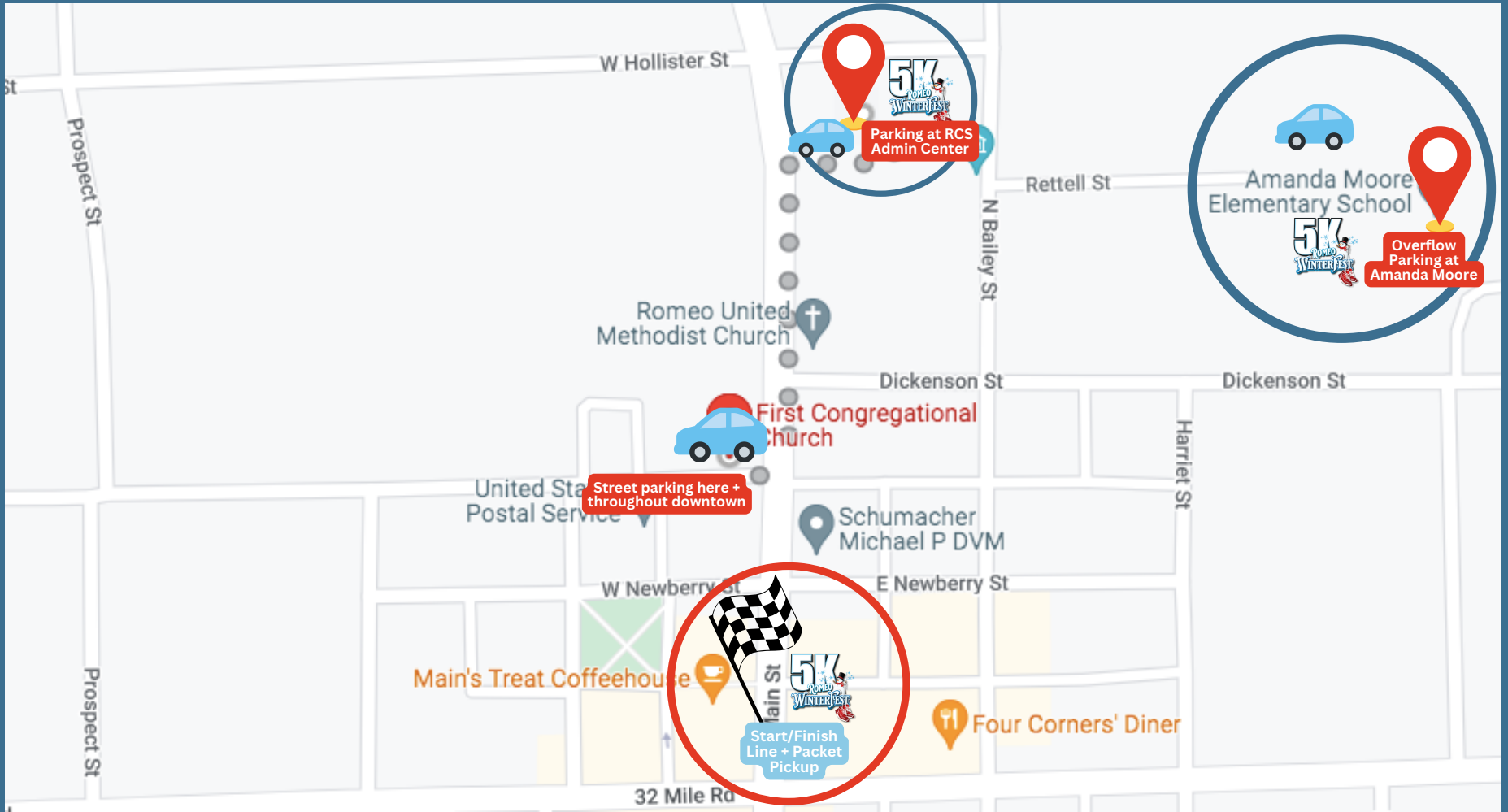
Parking on Race Day

While street parking is available, there will be parking lots reserved for race participants and WinterFest attendees which include the following:

- **Street Parking:** There is plenty of street parking through downtown Romeo
- **Romeo Community Schools Administrative Center:** 316 N Main St, Romeo, MI 48065 (*two blocks north of race day packet pickup location*)
- **Overflow parking option:** Amanda Moore Elementary, 209 Dickenson St, Romeo, MI 48065 (*0.50 miles from race day packet pickup location*)

SNOWMAN DASH DETAILS

This is a short **100 meter dash for kids!** We'll place cones (to indicate the start) 100 meters from the 5k's start/finish line and kids will dash to the finish.

All snowman dash participants will receive a **race bib** (*should be picked up at Friday's early packet pickup or Saturday morning's packet pickup*) and a finisher's medal at the finish line!



5K AND 1 MILE RACE DETAILS

Key points for 5K & 1 Mile participants:

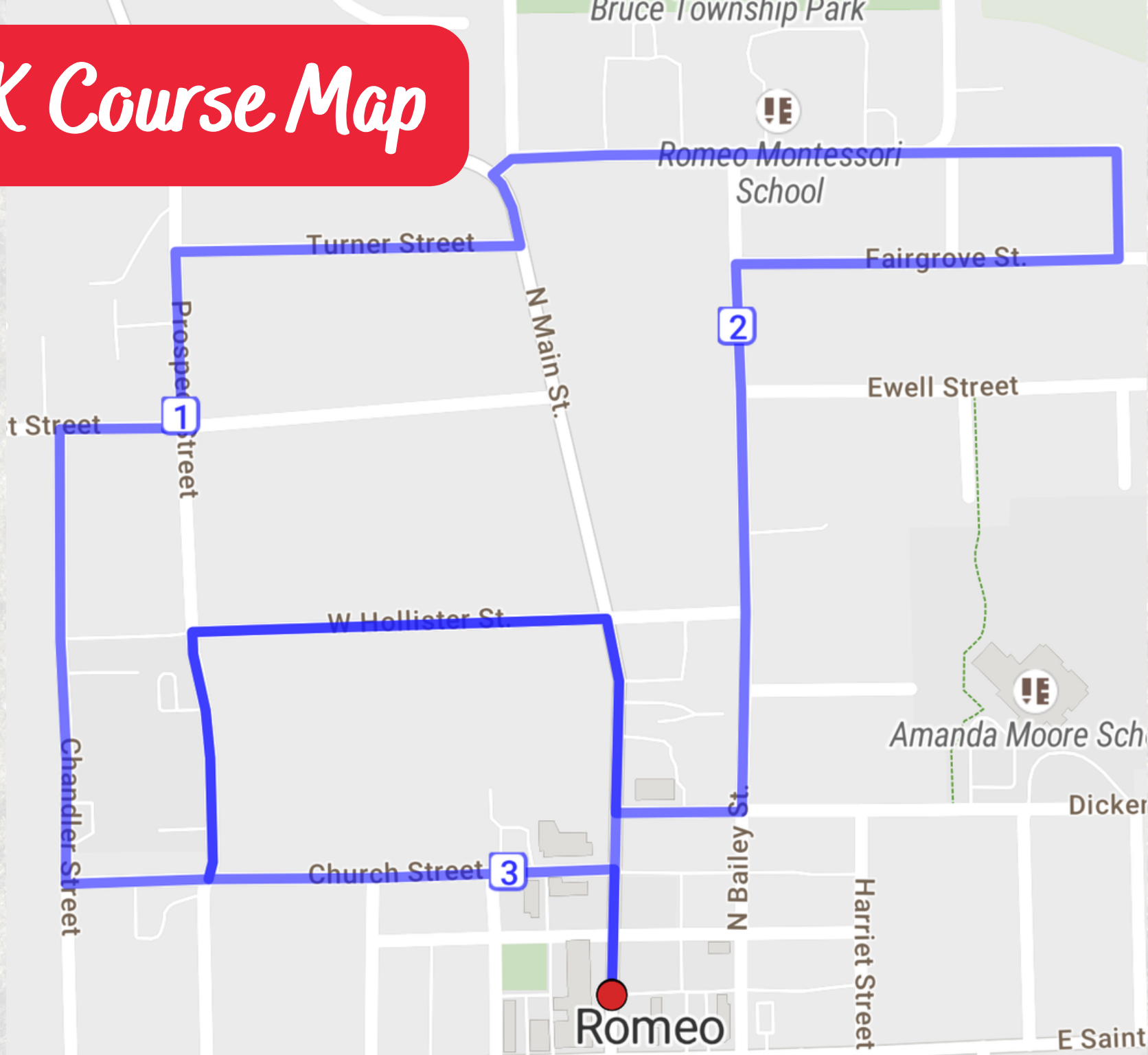
- We kindly ask that **walkers** start in the back (*this helps limit the amount of passing and traffic at the start*)
- **Please pin your race bib** to the front of your shirt/jacket so finish line volunteers can pass out finisher's medals to those who registered with swag. Pins will be provided at both packet pickups.

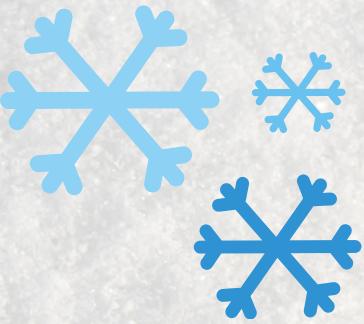




NEW COURSE MAPS

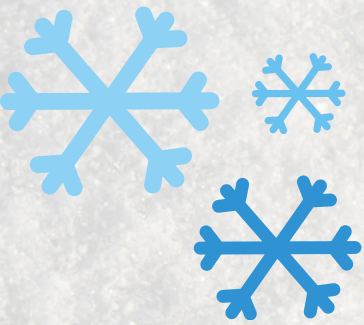
5K Course Map

Left on Prospect (.46) - Road will
be used again last mile
Right on Church St. (.61) - Road
will be used again last mile
Right on Chandler St. (.69)
Right on Minot (.94)
Left on Prospect (1 mile)
Right on Turner (1.11)
Left on Main (1.31)
Right on Gates (1.34)
Right on Haber St. (1.71)
Right on Fairgrove (1.77)
Left on Bailey (2 mile)
Right on Dickenson (2.3)
Right on Main St. (2.36)
Left on Hollister (2.47)
Left on Prospect (2.71)
Left on Church (2.85)
Right on Main Street (3.08)
5k Finish 3.12 just North of 32

5K AGE GROUP AWARDS
