Who is eligible to participate in the King and Queen of the prom contest?

There are 24 online spots available. 12 Males and 12 Females. Anyone age 21 and up can participate in the fundraiser. All registrants are self-nominated.

Can fundraisers edit their profile page and donation page?

Yes, the profile page can be edited and a picture in (jpg format) can be added to the profile.

Can I share my donation page on social media?

Yes, there is a link for sharing on a variety of social media platforms. Facebook, Twitter and Email.

Do I have to attend the prom to win the title?

All participants must attend the prom in order to be considered for prom king or queen.

When are the Prom King and Queen selected?

Before the prom takes place, there will already have been a virtual round of voting. During the first round, twelve men and twelve women will be registered. In the onsite voting round, the participants will have the opportunity to collect donations during the prom. Onsite donations will be accepted until 8:00 p.m. The top 6 fundraisers will be a part of the King and Queen's court.

What time is the crowning?

We will begin the coronation ceremony around 9:50. The top male fundraiser will be crowned King and the top female fundraiser will be crowned Queen. The King and Queen will receive a crown and sash. The Court members will receive a ribbon.

How much can I donate?

The minimum donation is \$1.00. There is no maximum amount that can be donated. There is a 4% processing fee for all donations.

Can I donate to Hamilton Lodge without selecting an individual fundraiser?

Yes, you can make monetary donation without selecting one of the participants for King or Queen.

Is my payment information secure?

Yes, the payment information is secure. The administrator does not have access to sensitive personal information other than the basic information used to sign up as a registrant and fundraiser.

Is an anonymous donation completely private?

No, there is partial anonymity for donations. The contest administrator and fundraiser are the only people who are able to tell how individuals donated. To everyone else, that's private information.

Who will receive the proceeds from the donations?

All donations less the processing fee will go to Hamilton Lodge.
