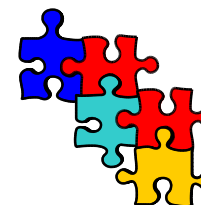

## BAILEY'S RUN FOR AUTISM

### LOCATION & ROUTE:

The run will start and finish on Payson Road and will continue left onto Chestnut Street, then onto Mechanic Street and up Baker going left on Chestnut to return right on Payson back at the start. This event is RAIN or SHINE!

### COURSE:

Fast, Flat course to encourage good race time!

### BAILEY'S RUN REGISTRATION FEE:

Entry fee is \$30 if pre-registered before the race. All on-site registrations (on race day) are \$35 and registration ends at 9:45 on site (April 12<sup>th</sup>).

**[THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS IF WE MUST CANCEL DUE TO SEVERE WEATHER CONDITIONS.]**

### WALK REGISTRATION & DETAILS:

Registration is required and ALL walkers must sign a waiver - adults must sign on behalf of their child(ren).

**We graciously ask that each person 12 years and older contributes \$10.00 to participate. We ask that walkers also consider collecting donations as they prepare to walk to support people with autism and their families.**

### T-SHIRTS:

**T-shirts are free for the first 200 registered RUNNERS. Register early for best size selection.**

### PARKING:

There is plenty of parking available at both The Payson Road Recreation Area and at Conrad's Restaurant where we ask you to join us for the awards presentation and after party.

### BAILEY'S RUN PRIZES:

Prizes will be awarded to the first three overall winners (male & female) and the top male and female in the following age groups: 12 & under, 13-18, 19-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60-69, 70+. **(We brought back "70+" at the request of our participants!)**

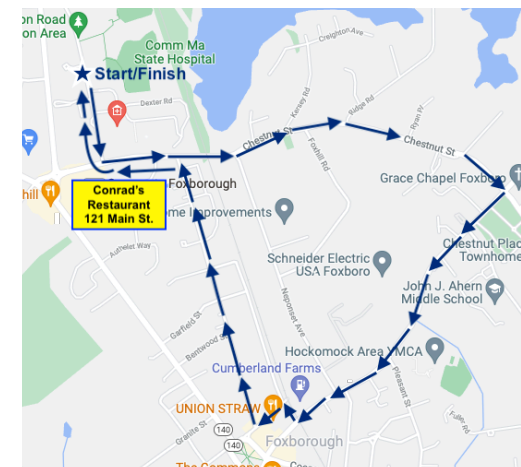
### REFRESHMENTS:

## COURSE MAP



- Start on Payson Road (actual start location to be clearly marked on day of race) and go towards Chestnut Street
- Take a left on Chestnut Street following to traffic lights
- Take a right on Mechanic Street following to railroad tracks
- Take a right on to Railroad Avenue
- Take a left on to Bird Street
- Take a right on to Baker Street to the end
- Take a left on to Chestnut Street
- Take a right onto Payson Road back to start

**We ask that walkers follow the designated one (1) mile route to return in time to cheer on the runners, and then drive or walk to Conrad's for the after party. [Walk route map will be provided at the event.]**

If walkers choose to walk 3.1 miles, please note that all participants will be at Conrad's at the time you arrive at the finish... we do hope you will join us for the fun!
