



We are excited to introduce the second annual **Triple Crown Series (TCS)** for wheelchair athletes. The series is a three-event point-based system for all levels: men/women in open, quad, masters and grand masters divisions. The purpose of the **TCS** is to help develop and grow the sport of wheelchair racing, providing a more competitive atmosphere for elite as well as up-and-coming wheelchair racers. The 2023 TCS proved to be successful, 27 athletes competed in all three events.

**Cedartown 5k – July 2 (Camp dates: June 30-July 3<sup>rd</sup>)**

**Peachtree 10k – July 4**

**Boilermaker 15k – July 14**

Racers will accumulate points for each event. After the final event, the top three in each division will earn a spot on the podium, prize money and bragging rights.

**Note:** Athlete standings will be posted on the official website at the end of each event so you can follow your progress and set goals for the next event.

#### **SERIES RULES:**

- All athletes must register in all (3) races to earn prize money.
- Athletes must register in the same division in all 3 races to qualify for prize money. (e.g. If you register for Peachtree in master's division, you must race in that division in all three events).

#### **REGISTRATION:**

Your registration in each individual event (Peachtree, Cedartown and Boilermaker) will automatically qualify you for the **TCS** point system) – **NO TCS** registration needed.

**TCS AWARDS: Prize Distribution in 5 Divisions – 2024 prize money increased.**

**TCS awards will be handed out as soon as the Boilermaker 15K results are available.**

1st place - \$500 (open men/women, T52 M, Master and Grand Masters)

2nd place- \$400 (open men/women, T52 M, Master and Grand Masters)

3rd place- \$300 (open men/women, T52 M, Master and Grand Masters)
