

Aid Stations

- The marathon will have a minimum of 14 aid stations.
- The half marathon will have a minimum of 5 aid stations.
- The 5k will have one aid station at the turnaround point mile 1.55.
- Gatorade (orange) and water will be available at **ALL** aid stations. Two aid stations on the marathon and one on the half route will feature Gu (chocolate & vanilla), pretzels, and bananas.
- There will be 5 portable bathrooms along the marathon route. There will be 2 on the half marathon route.

Final aid station locations will be released the week of the event.

Results & Spectating

- Results can be found online on the race website. They will be updated throughout the morning.
- There is one check point on the full marathon course, at the 13.1 mile mark.
- If you have family or friends who plan to spectate, please advise them to park on adjacent streets and walk to the course. Do not park or drive on the course.
