#### **Notes for Packet Pick-Up**

Walk-up registration will be available during Packet Pick-Up if the event has not sold out. A photo ID is required for all participants. You may pick up a packet for a friend if you bring a copy or photo of their ID (digital photos on cell phones are accepted — no exceptions). We strongly encourage everyone to attend the pre-race packet pick-up. Out-of-town participants may pick up their packets on race morning starting at **6:30 a.m.**, though this option is **discouraged** to avoid delays.

#### **PARKING**

We strongly encourage carpooling to the event. Parking is available at Tidelands Park but is first come, first serve. Parking will also be available on residential streets in Coronado. Please obey all posted parking signs and restrictions and do not block driveways. The race will start promptly at 8:00 am. Due to Thanksgiving tourist congestion on Coronado, race organizers cannot guarantee parking will be readily available or easy near the start line. Please plan accordingly by arriving early.

**Tidelands Park** is first come, first serve. Arrive before 6:45AM as this lot will be full prior to 7:00am.

Cars parked in the Smart & Final or Broadstone Apartment Complex parking lots will be subject to towing. The Marriot and Ferry Landing offer paid parking with rates ranging between \$10-\$30. Prices are subject to change based on vendor pricing.

There is free street parking close to the park. Plan to walk as far as one mile to the start line

\*Please be aware of all signs when parking, Easy Day Sports will not be responsible for towed cars.

**RIDESHARE:** Instead of parking on the island, park on the other side of the bridge in Barrio Logan and Uber across. There is ample free street parking near Chicano Park and Perkins Elementary School, located at 1770 Main Street. Exit Cesar Chavez Blvd on the San Diego side of the bridge. Plan on parking 1-hour prior to your start time.

### **5K COURSE INFORMATION**

#### **Course Description**

The Coronado Turkey Trot 5K starts and finishes at beautiful **Tidelands Park**, taking runners and walkers on a scenic waterfront journey along the Bayshore Bikeway.

After crossing the start line, you'll head south toward the Coronado Bridge Viewpoint for the **first turnaround just before Mile 1**. Enjoy open bay views and wide pathways as you make your way back toward Tidelands Park.

Continuing north along the water, you'll reach **Water Station #1**, offering a quick refresh as you head toward the Ferry Landing.

The course then guides you along the bayside path just past the **Coronado Ferry Landing**, where you'll arrive at **Water Station #2** and the **second turnaround point around Mile 2.25**.

From there, take in the waterfront scenery as you follow the Bayshore Bikeway back to Tidelands Park. You'll cross the finish line under the arch and celebrate your Thanksgiving morning with friends, family, and the Coronado community.

#### **Course Rules & Safety Guidelines:**

We appreciate your cooperation in keeping the event safe and enjoyable for all participants!

- We will have two water stations on course. Be sure to stay hydrated.
- Strollers are permitted but must start in the designated stroller section.
- For safety, only children under 6 are allowed to bring scooters.
- Follow the instructions of course marshals and volunteers to ensure a smooth race for everyone.


#### **Wave Start**

We will utilize a "Fast, Fit, Fun" wave start in addition to pacers to accommodate the number of participants we expect at this year's event. Your timing tag will activate and start once you cross the start line timing mats. All runners will start at 8:00am.

\*Please line up by your expected pace/mile time – fastest to slowest. For the safety of others, all strollers and walkers, please stage in the back.

#### **Walkers Etiquette**

Walkers, please keep in mind that portions of the course are narrow. Walkers should be no more than two people wide to ensure runners can pass by safely.



#### **Water Stations**

There will be **two water stations** along the 5K course to keep you hydrated throughout the run:

Water Station #1 – Located near Tidelands Park, approximately 1.5 miles into the course.

Water Station #2 – Located near the Coronado Ferry Landing, approximately 2.25 miles into the course.

Both stations will offer water and have clearly marked trash and recycling areas to help keep the course clean.

#### **Post-Race Refreshments**

After crossing the finish line, runners can rehydrate with water provided by **Open Water** and refuel with a banana courtesy of **Boney's Bayside Market**.

#### **Results/Athlete Tracking**

Results will be posted immediately following the event.

#### Awards/Medals\*

Age Group Awards: Awards will be presented to the top three runners in the 5K race at each USATF-recommended age. Overall, winners will be excluded from age group awards. Top 3 male/female finishers in each of the 8 age groups below:

Under 13 14-19 20-29 30-39 40-49 50-59 60-69 70+.

Overall Winners: This year's overall 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place male and female finishers in both the 5K will receive an award medal.
