The Rains Foundation is a charitable organization dedicated to the principles championed by Lyndon Rains: scholarship, athleticism, physical vigor, sportsmanship, commerce, entrepreneurship. Inspired by the overwhelming response in donations for a Memorial Scholarship Fund upon Lyndon's passing, the family was moved to create the Foundation. The Scholarship Fund was further enhanced by the kindness of donors in honor of the passing of Jo Ann Rains in 2013. The Foundation is a 501(c)(3) charitable foundation, and donations are tax-deductible.

The Foundation:

- Awards graduation scholarships for after high school education in every county in which Lyndon's business operates: Fentress, Morgan, Cumberland and Putnam as well as Pickett County where he was raised.
- Sponsors a Summer Youth Golf Clinic to teach principles of athleticism, scholarship, and sportsmanship and self-reliance to young people. An experienced youth golf coach conducts the Clinic.
- Hosts a Memorial Charity Golf Tournament each July. The 9th Annual Lyndon Rains Memorial Golf Tournament was held at the Golden Eagle Golf Club in Cookeville. The 2016 LRMGT was the most successful yet, raising over \$20,000 for the Scholarship Fund. Over \$225,000 in scholarships have been awarded to more than 75 young scholar/golfers since the Foundation's inception.
- Supports a number of athletic and business oriented organizations.
