- A mask

The Swag

All athletes participating will receive a custom fully sublimated Moonlight Bootlegger shirt, finishers glass, Fainting Goat Spirits Hand Sanitizer, wooden medal, and a chance to win a swing-top Bootlegger bottle!!



Rules and Changes

1. No person-to-person packet pickup or medal distribution. Packets will be pre-bagged and numbered with athlete's race bib, shirt, medal, safety pins, and goodies. Athletes will pick up their packets at a drive-thru packet pick up on the way into the park before their scheduled race. Athletes will also get temperature checked at this time. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or greater will be turned away from the event. Please have a MASK on when driving up!
2. There will be no race day registration. Online registration will close at midnight the night before the race.
3. Results will be available online, there will not be any results Kiosks onsite
4. Awards will be distributed immediately following event. No awards will be mailed out. As awards are called out, athletes will pick up awards from a table and will be required to wear a mask in order to pick theirs up. There will be no contact between athletes and Trivium staff.
5. **No spectators will be allowed.** Please make sure to follow this rule. The park will shut the entire event down if we go over our limit!
6. We will not have food or cocktails after the race for safety and to eliminate the urge to gather. Instead of receiving your alcohol in a cocktail, you will get a custom spray bottle of Fainting Goat Spirits Hand Sanitizer made with the same quality ingredients and loving care as their vodka, gin, and whisky!
7. Athletes will start over the course of 10 minutes. You will receive a chip start time, so don't worry about crowding or rushing to get across! The start line will have social distance X's marked on the ground.

Race Changes and Rules Continued

8. Social distancing of at least 6ft will be required at all times except with members of the same household.
9. No headphones. As you will need to maintain 6ft distance between yourself and other runners on the course, so you need to be able to hear anyone coming along to pass.
10. The course will be modified to remove any sections that would have two-way traffic
11. There will be no water stops, athletes will be required to provide their own aid. (If the temperatures determines a water stop is NECESSARY due to heat, water will be provided in the form of individual small bottles that have been sanitized.)
12. Athletes will be required to wear a face mask covering their nose and mouth prior to and following the run. Athletes not following this rule are subject to being disqualified from the event.
13. All Trivium staff will wear masks
14. There will be no volunteers on course, only turn signs directing athletes where necessary. The course will be over marked with tea lights, tape, turn signs, and LED foam sticks

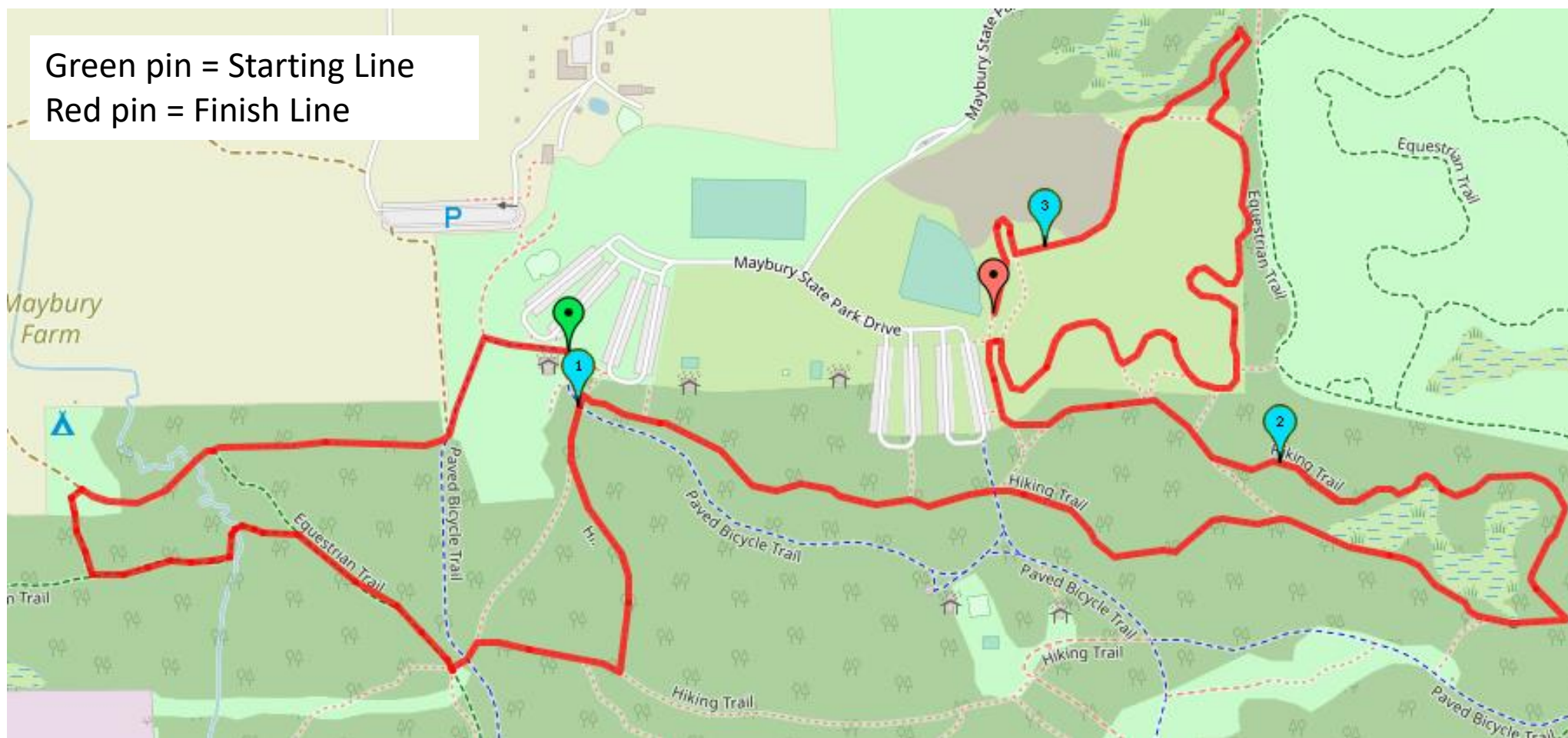
