Arriving at the Park

Parking Fees:

- Non-Resident Annual Pass: \$40
- Michigan Recreation Passport (ALL Michigan license plates): \$19
- All vehicles registered in Michigan will need the Recreation Passport for \$19. There is not a day pass for in-state vehicles.
- The pass can be purchased from the Secretary of State when renewing tabs for a discounted rate of \$14.
- Non-Resident Daily Pass: \$11
- Maybury State Park is part of the MI State Parks System and therefore requires a [Recreation Passport](#) for entry.

Parking is available in either of the two large main lots near the start and finish line.

Parking

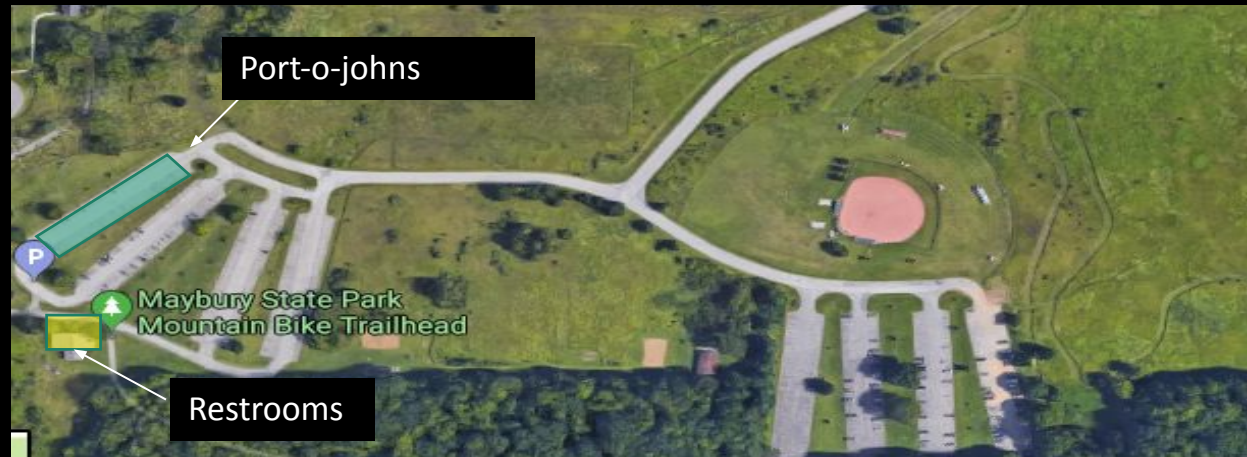
There is plenty of parking at the race site. Please show up early so you have plenty of time to pick up your packet and make your way to the start line.

Registration and packet pickup will close **PROMPTLY** at 8:45pm to give us time to walk you over to the race starting line!



Bathrooms

We will have plenty of port-o-johns near the main parking area. There are also bathrooms inside the pavilion near registration and 3 more outhouses along the tree line behind the pavilion



ID Check

To be able to enjoy your post-race cocktail you are required to complete an ID check. Please make sure to bring your ID and have this completed prior to the race start.

There will be a separate tent near registration to complete this.

Runners under 21 or those who do not have an ID will still be able to enjoy a non-alcoholic mocktail and other refreshments.

Things to Remember

1. The better your headlamp/flashlight, the easier, and safer the event is!
2. If you want to drink you MUST bring your ID. Volunteers and workers have been instructed to have a zero-tolerance policy **no matter what your age is.**
3. Do not rip your drink ticket off your bib ahead of time. To help prevent over serving, drink tickets will only be used if they are pulled off at the time of serving
4. BIBS GO ON THE FRONT (please do not put the bib on your back, under another shirt, or on your leg) or we cannot guarantee a finish time.
5. You must start in the start wave/corral you picked! If you need to change your wave/corral, please do so at packet pickup or online prior to the event, do not just switch at the start line without talking to a race director.

Course Markings

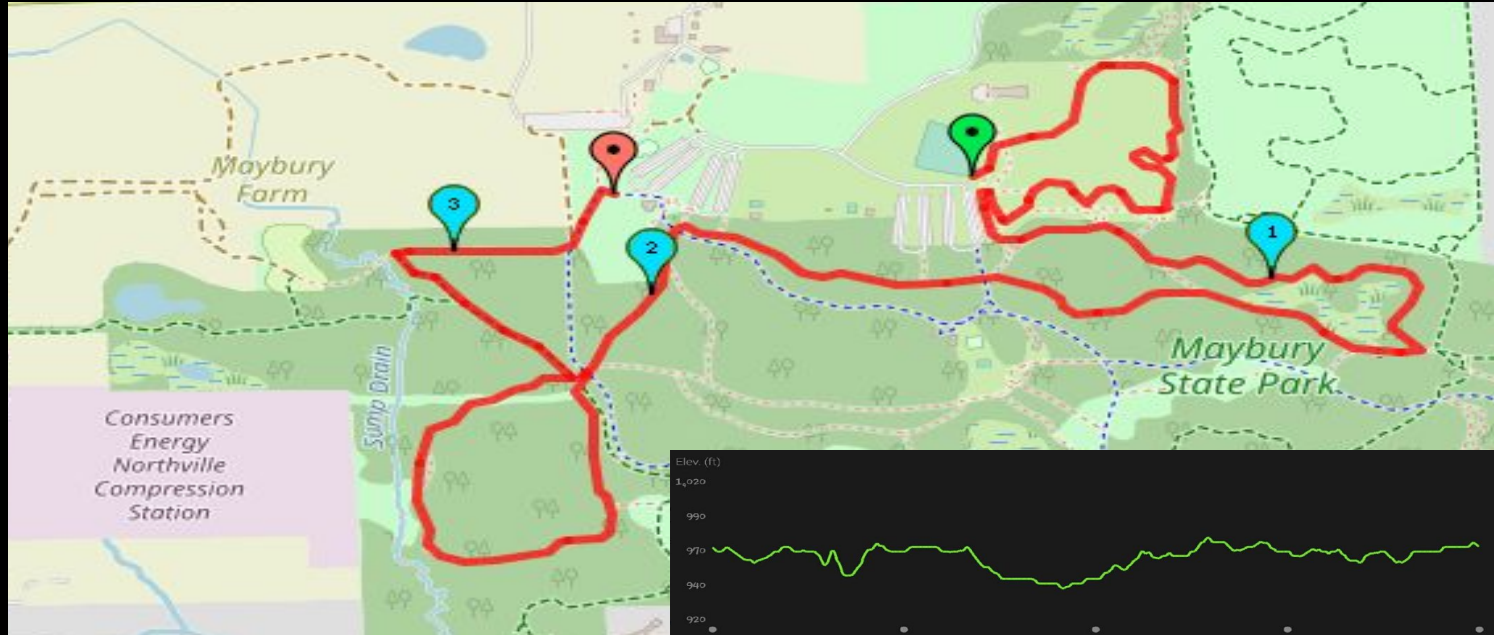


We do everything we can to make sure you are safe, and on the right course at The Moonlight Bootlegger 5K.

- We will have volunteers at major areas where you could possibly go the wrong way.
- Each turn will have a turn sign staked into the ground pointing you in the correct direction
- Trails where you might go the wrong way will also be taped off
- The entire course will have 350 LED tea lights on the **RIGHT** side of the trail. While these do not illuminate the trail, you will see them every 30 feet or so to help let you know you are still on course.
- It's tough to SEE mile markers in the dark so we will be placing speakers at each of the miles. If you come up on old timey music in the woods, you know you have reached the next mile.

Course

This is a fairly flat course with a total elevation gain of 100 ft.
