


Run or Walk in Honor of a Sister!

Photography and Video Release

Participants involved in any activities, including the "Get Moving at the Mount 5K Run/Walk" (hereinafter the "Race"), offered by St. Joseph's Female Ursuline Academy, Inc. (aka and hereinafter Ursuline Sisters of Mount Saint Joseph) may be photographed or videotaped during event. I, the undersigned, hereby consent to the use of any of these photographs, video, or any accompanying audio recordings without compensation on the Ursuline Sisters of Mount Saint Joseph website or in any editorial, promotional, or advertising material produced or published by or on behalf of the Ursuline Sisters of Mount Saint Joseph. I understand that my image may be edited, copied, exhibited, published or distributed and waive the right to inspect or approve the finished product wherein my likeness appears. I further acknowledge that any video footage in which I appear may be uploaded to the Internet and viewable on websites including, but not limited to popular social media platforms such as Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn or Youtube. **INITIALS:**

Waiver and Release of Liability

I acknowledge that running a road race is a potentially hazardous activity. I acknowledge that I should not enter the "Get Moving at the Mount 5K Run/Walk" (hereinafter the "Race") unless I am physically and medically able to do so and properly trained, and that I am solely responsible for determining my ability and fitness to do so. I further agree that it is always advisable to consult a physician before undertaking any physically demanding activity, especially if I am pregnant or disabled in any way, or if I have recently suffered an illness, injury, or impairment. I further agree to emergency medical care and transportation in order to obtain treatment in the event of injury to me as medical professionals may deem appropriate and I agree that I will be responsible for any costs associated with my medical care. I assume all risks associated with participating in the "Get Moving at the Mount 5K Run/Walk" (hereinafter the "Race") in Maple Mount, Kentucky, including but not limited to injuries arising from slips, falls, any defects or conditions of the premises, the weather, including but not limited to cold, high heat and/or humidity, traffic, and the other participants in the Race, all such risks being known and appreciated by me. In consideration of your accepting my entry to participate in the Race, I do hereby for myself, my heirs, my executors and administrators, waive and forever release any and all rights and claims related to and/or arising out of my participation in the Race against all persons, entities and agencies involved with promoting the Race, including but not limited to the Ursuline Sisters of Mount Saint Joseph, the Diocese of Owensboro, the Archdiocese of Louisville, the Catholic Church, and all sponsors, volunteers and associates and their respective agents, successors, representatives and assigns from any and all claims in said event even though liability may arise out of negligence or gross negligence on the part of the persons named in this waiver. (hereinafter collectively the "Sponsor(s)") I assume the risk of all bodily injuries, including death, resulting therefrom,

and personal injuries to me and damage to and loss of my property, including loss of use thereof and any other indirect or consequential damages, resulting directly or indirectly, wholly or in part, from my participation in the Race and while traveling to and from the Race. I further agree to indemnify, defend and hold the Sponsor(s) specifically named herein harmless from and against any and all claims, liabilities, losses, damages, costs, expenses (including attorney's fees), judgments and penalties arising out of any of my acts or omissions to act. In the event that the participant is a person under 18 years of age, the undersigned parent or legal guardian of the participant agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Sponsor(s) named herein from and against all claims, liabilities, losses, damages, costs, expenses (including attorney's fees), judgments, and penalties arising out of the participant's participation in the Race. I understand and agree that all entry fees are nonrefundable and nontransferable. Further, I acknowledge and agree that the Sponsor(s), in their sole discretion, may delay or cancel the Race if they believe that the conditions on race day are unsafe. In the event that the Race is delayed or cancelled for any reason, including, but not limited to: fire, threatened or actual strike, protest, labor difficulty, work stoppage, insurrection, war, public disaster, flood, unavoidable casualty, acts of God or the elements (including without limitation, rain, snow, ice, hail, high winds, thunderstorm, lightening, tornado, earthquake), or any other cause beyond the control of the Sponsor(s), there shall be no refund of the entry fee or any other costs of the entrant in connection with the Race.

I agree that in the case of legal action that the sole and exclusive jurisdiction is in Daviess County, Kentucky and that only the substantive laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky shall apply. I further agree that if any provision of this waiver is held to be unenforceable in a judicial proceeding then that provision shall be severed from the agreement, and that the remainder of this waiver shall remain operative and binding on the parties. BY INDICATING YOUR ACCEPTANCE OF THIS WAIVER, YOU ARE AFFIRMING THAT YOU HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THIS WAIVER AND FULLY UNDERSTAND ITS TERMS. YOU UNDERSTAND THAT YOU ARE GIVING UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS, INCLUDING THE RIGHT TO SUE. YOU ACKNOWLEDGE THAT YOU ARE SIGNING THE AGREEMENT AND WAIVER FREELY AND VOLUNTARILY, AND INTEND BY YOUR ACCEPTANCE TO BE A COMPLETE AND UNCONDITIONAL RELEASE OF ALL LIABILITY TO THE GREATEST EXTENT ALLOWED BY LAW.

You must be over 18 years of age OR the parent/legal guardian of a minor under 18 years of age OR the legal guardian of an incapacitated and/or mentally challenged person in order to sign this Waiver.

₩What is the "Get Moving at the Mount 5K"?

This is a "fun run" put on by the Ursuline Sisters of Mount Saint Joseph and is an event the whole family can participate in.

How far is a 5K?

A 5K (or 5 kilometers) is 3.1 miles.

∠Where will the 5K take place?

The Get Moving at the Mount 5K Run/Walk will take place at Mount Saint Joseph in Maple Mount, Kentucky (12 miles west of Owensboro on Highway 56). The route will begin at the park (where the annual Mount Saint Joseph BBQ Picnic takes place) and will take you around the beautiful property of Mount Saint Joseph. ॐ Who will benefit from the 5K?

All proceeds will go to the mission of the Ursuline Sisters of Mount Saint Joseph. How will the Sisters be participating?

The sisters will be participating in many ways by walking, helping and cheering you on!

☎Do I have to be a runner to participate?

Absolutely not! The Get Moving at the Mount 5K is all about having fun with the family and the sisters. Runners, walkers, strollers, wheelchairs, children and adults are all welcome to participate. Runners will be allowed to go first with walkers following.

Can I bring my dog?

Dogs are allowed if on a leash. Dog walkers will follow the walkers at the starting line.

∠What happens if it rains?

If it rains the race will go on! However, if serious weather occurs we will postpone the race until it is safe to proceed.

Are there any age restrictions?

No! People of all ages are welcome to participate. If you are under 18, you will need a parent or guardian to sign a waiver before you can participate. If you are under 11, you will also need a responsible adult to participate with you. Children 6 and under do not have to be registered unless they want a T-shirt.

Will the race be timed? Will the winners receive anything?

The race will be chip timed by To The Finish.

Awards will be given to the winners in specified age categories.
