



**Where do I pick up my packet?** Pre-Race shirt and bib pick-up is at Leggett's Sand Bar, 217 First Avenue, Manasquan the night before the race (Friday) from 6-9pm and on race morning (Saturday) from 8:30-10:30am.

**Where do I park?** There are free municipal parking lots on 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue and 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue in Manasquan. You may also use street parking, but please avoid parking on the race course (see map of course) and areas where parking is not allowed.

**Can I bring a stroller?** You can use a stroller, but we ask you start in the back of the pack to make sure no toes get rolled over and nobody accidentally trips.

**Do I have to wear a costume?** No, costumes are not required to run or walk...only to participate in the costume contest!

**I was a fundraiser and might be one of the top fundraisers who would earn a prize. When can I find out?** Prizes will be given out during the after-party inside Leggett's after the race is over and all of our runners/walkers are in.

**Can friends and family come to cheer me on?** Of course! The more the merrier! They can even hang out inside Leggett's while waiting for you to complete the run.

**When does registration close?** On-line registration closes the Thursday before the race at 11:59 pm.

**Once online registration closes, can I still register?** Yes, we will have on-site registration at Leggett's Sand Bar, 217 First Avenue, Manasquan on Friday night prior to the race from 6pm-9pm and on race day (Saturday)

from 8:30-10:30am. On-site registration is \$35. You are NOT guaranteed a Spooktacular shirt with race day registration, as those are reserved for the first 400 registrants only.

**How do I turn in my donations?** You can either raise money online or turn your donations in at packet pick-up, on race day; or mail to us at: STOMP the Monster PO Box 521 Marlboro, NJ 07746 Attn: Spooktacular Fundraising. Thank you for your support!

**If I can't make it, will you refund my registration fee?** No, registration for this event is non-refundable and non-transferable. If you cannot make it on race day, we will consider your registration a donation to STOMP the Monster.

**What do I get with my registration?** You will receive a race bib to participate in the run or walk course. You also get FREE buffet lunch at Leggett's Sand Bar. The first 400 registered participants are also guaranteed a shirt.

**Will there be food after the race?** Yes, plenty of food (pizza, wings, salad, sausage, etc.) will be provided by Leggett's Sand Bar after the race.

**Will there be awards after the race?** Yes, after the race is over and all runners and walkers are in, the DJ inside Leggett's will announce the top 3 male and top 3 female finishers. Top fundraisers and best costume prizes will also be announced during the after-party. All will receive Stomp the Monster swag. \*\*\*You must be present to receive your swag\*\*\*

**Are there award categories?**

Yes. Stomp the Monster swag will be given to the following winners:  
Top 3 Overall Male and Female finishers of the full 3.92 mile course.  
3 Best Costumes (individual or group costumes)  
3 Top fundraisers.

**Does all of it go to charity?** Yes, net proceeds collected from race registration/fundraising go to STOMP the Monster to help local cancer patients.

**Where is the starting location?** At the beach area known as Sea Watch (parking lot near the corner of Ocean and First Avenues).

### **What is the EVENT timeline?**

### **Are there restrooms available?**

Yes, you may use the bathrooms inside Leggett's anytime that day, and there is a bathroom at the Start.

### **What if I want to walk and not run?**

We have almost 2-mile walk course just for you! Walkers will start at the back of the pack. And if you want to walk the whole 4-mile course, go for it! The Manasquan police may need to ask you to stay on the sidewalk after a certain amount of time (when they need to re-open the roads)...but we'll still be at the finish line cheering you in!
