

**WHAT:** **HUMAN TRUCK PULL** – Teams will pull a 17,000 lb. semi with a 53 ft. trailer as fast as they can 125 feet. Prizes and bragging rights will be awarded for Fastest Team (Co-ed and Men’s), Most money raised and Crowd Favorite. Men’s teams will be made up of 10 team members and co-ed teams will be made up of 12.

**WHEN:** **Saturday, Sept. 19 – Registration at 9:00 am** Opening Ceremony at 10:00 am with first pull to follow. Awards ceremony to follow final pull.

**WHERE:** **Anderson Municipal Airport -282 Airport Rd, Anderson**

**WHY:** Event will benefit thousands of individuals and families across all of Madison County by supporting programs that give opportunities for individuals and families to THRIVE. Efforts that both help young children to succeed in school and families to find ways to financially thrive.

**COST:** **\$500 per team (minimum)**  
Teams must either pay a \$500 entry fee and/or raise a minimum of \$500 in fundraising to participate. Online fundraising pages are available for free. Team members who compete will receive a t-shirt at the the pull. Non-pulling supporters can also help raise money.

**NEW:** **NEW THIS YEAR!** Kid’s Exhibition Pull! Kids are invited to join in a kid’s group pull as parents and all those in attendance cheer them on. Cost is \$5 per child and a signed waiver is required.

**EXTRAS:** Food Trucks, Kids Area, Event Merchandise and Music! Bring your friends and family to watch and cheer on the teams. Admission is \$2 for adults and \$1 for kids 3 - 12. 2 and under FREE.

# HUMAN TRUCK PULL RULES AND INFORMATION

- 1) Men's teams must consist of 10 members. Co-ed teams must consist of 12 members with at least 4 being female. Individuals can compete on only one team. If there are enough teams in each category to compete, separate divisions for mens and co-ed will be used.
- 2) Team members must be 16 or over. If under 18, a minor release form is required.
- 3) Team entry form must be turned in before Friday, September 11 at United Way of Madison County, by email to [k.williams@unitedwaymadisonco.org](mailto:k.williams@unitedwaymadisonco.org), by fax at 765-608-3065 or in person at 1201 E. 5th Street, Suite 1019, Anderson IN 46012.
- 4) All participants must sign a waiver before pulling in the competition. Waivers are available in the team packet, online at [www.unitedwaymadisonco.org/truckpull](http://www.unitedwaymadisonco.org/truckpull) and at event.
- 5) This will be a timed event. Fastest time of the final round competition will win. Two timers will be used on each lane.
- 6) For the competition, teams will take turns pulling a semi against at least one other team. The fastest teams will move onto a semi-final round where pulling will occur again. The two fastest teams from the semi-final round will compete in a final head-to-head pull that will produce a winner. In the event of a tie, the team with the highest money raised prior to the competition wins. Multiple teams may pull against each other at the same time with individual times being recorded for each.
- 7) No team member substitutions may be made after the first pull. We encourage alternates to be on hand the day of the event so that last minute participant holes may be filled before the first pull.
- 8) Teams will pull one rope. No knots can be added.
- 9) The rope will be taped at 20 feet; No member can be between the tape and the truck.
- 10) Before the pull, rope must be held in one hand only and down to your side until officially told to pull. Starter will officially start each pull and then the clock begins.
- 11) No twisting of the rope around any part of the body, hands or waists. No weight belts that attach to the rope are allowed.
- 12) All team members are encouraged to wear hand protection.
- 13) Participants are encouraged to wear appropriate shoes. No cowboy boots or sandals. No spikes or cleats.
- 14) All decisions from the judges will be final.
- 15) Prizes will be awarded at the completion of the event for Fastest Time Overall, Fastest time in each division, and most money raised (prior to event). Remember this is a fundraising event! A NEW "Crowd Favorite" award will also be given for the team raising the most money AT THE EVENT. Teams are encouraged to put together their own collection jar and solicitation efforts to encourage attendees to support their team for "Crowd Favorite" through donations at the event.
