
# **RRCA State Championship**



### Do Not Switch Race Numbers

It is important that you not switch your number with anyone else. Only participants with a number will be allowed on the course.

Be sure to bring your bib number with you on race day ... it IS your timing device!!

# Safety

Please take the time to write your name and any pertinent emergency information on the back of your bib. For the safety of all concerned, the course is restricted to runners, walkers, self-propelled wheelchairs (under WSUSA rules; helmets and brakes required) and official racing strollers. Dogs, Bicycles, Roller Skates, Roller Blades, Wagons, Skateboards, and Motorized Wheelchairs are not allowed.

\*RRCA regulations proscribe the use of headphones.
