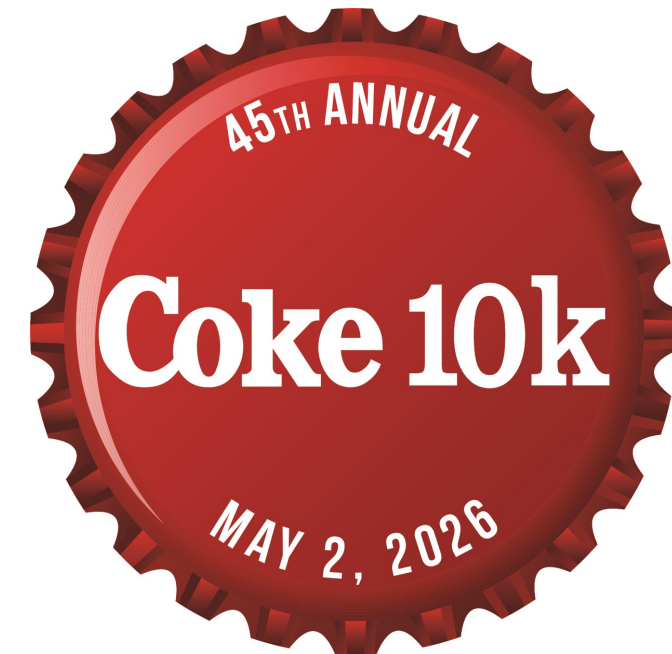

Do Not Switch Race Numbers

For the INTEGRITY of accurate race results, it is imperative that you NOT switch your number with anyone else. Only participants with a number will be allowed on the course. Be sure to bring your bib with you on race day ... it IS your timing device!!

Safety

Please take the time to write your name and any pertinent emergency information on the back of your bib. For the safety of all concerned, the course is restricted to runners, walkers, self-propelled wheelchairs (under WSUSA rules; helmets and brakes required) and official racing strollers. Dogs, Bicycles, Roller Skates, Roller Blades, Wagons, Skateboards, and Motorized Wheelchairs are not allowed.

*RRCA regulations proscribe the use of headphones.

Age Divisions

Age group trophies are uniquely designed gold Coca-Cola bottles mounted on dark wooden bases - a real keepsake! Trophies will be given to men and women for First, Second, Third, Fourth, and Fifth places in the following age divisions:

Larger trophies will be given to overall winners for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place, masters and grand masters winners. (no duplications)
