

Trick-Or-Trot 5k Trail Run - October 19, 2019

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (last revised 10/18/19- JO)

Where does the race start/finish? Ann Dever Park, 6791 San Casa Drive, Englewood.

When does the race start? The race is scheduled to start at 8:00 a.m.

Is there an advance packet pick up before the race? Yes, Real Bikes Englewood from 2:30 – 6:30 pm Friday October 18th.

When does day of registration / packet pick up open / close? Registration at Ann Dever Park, Englewood, opens 6:30 a.m. and closes at 7:45 a.m.

Can I pay day of registration by credit card/cash/check? You can pay by cash or by check (made out to 'Zoomers'). Day of registration is \$30 for everyone. We do **NOT** accept credit card payment.

Can I have a different size t-shirt than the one I ordered? You will receive the shirt you requested when you registered. If, and only if, there are shirts available **after the race** will different sizes be considered.

What is the course like? The course starts in the parking lot area then heads into the trail. The trail is wide and consists of crushed shell and dirt. It is not very technical. There are two bridges, one small and flat, and the other inclines as it goes over Oyster Creek. The course is a

'lollipop' loop so you will be crossing the two bridges again as you head towards the finish. The finish ends in the parking lot area.

Is there plenty of available parking? Yes, there are three nearby lots off of San Casa that will accommodate all expected participants. Please follow directions of parking volunteers.

Are there plenty of bathrooms? Where are they located? Yes, there are indoor bathrooms at Ann Dever Memorial Regional Park. The number of bathrooms meet 1:75 participant race standards. Additional portajohns will be rented if necessary.

How will race be timed? Will there be mile markers ... clocks on the course? The race is chip-timed (chip in bib) by Durti Timing, gun start and using a finish line mat. There will be mile markers on the course. There will be no split times on the course.

Is there a water stop out on the course? Yes, there will be one water stop. It's near Mile 2. There will also be water at the start line and at the immediate finish line area.

Will there be emergency personnel on site? Yes, there will be Basic Life Support (BLS) level of medical care on site. Charlotte County Fire Station #13 is located across from Ann Dever Park.

Where is the best place for my family/friends to view the race? Because it is a trail run, the best place for your family to view the race is at the start and finish.

What about awards? Trophies will be awarded to top male and female in the following categories: Overall, Youth, Masters, Grand Masters, Sr. Grand Masters, Veterans Masters. There will be medals awarded to the top three male and females in each of the following age groups: 8 and under, 9 to 10, 11 to 12, 13 to 14 as well as 5 year age groups from 15-19 to 75 and above.

What about the weather? If it's raining, we will still run. The race may be postponed or canceled if there is lightning in the area. Race officials will monitor the weather and make a final decision on race morning. No refunds will be given.
