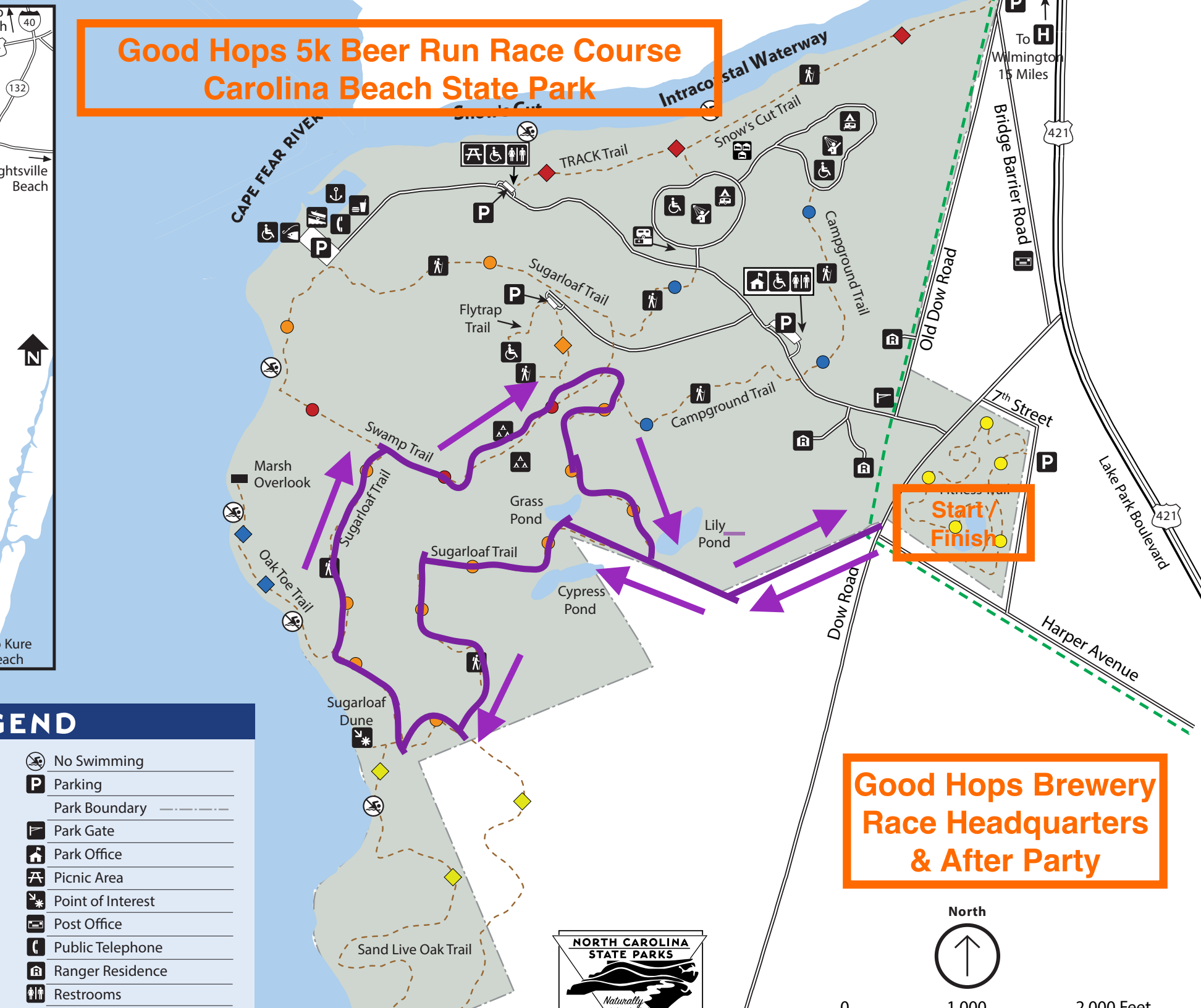


Good Hops 5k Beer Run Race Course Carolina Beach State Park

- Flytrap Trail**
This pleasant, winding trail through the pocosin wetlands and savanna community along the edges of the park. Flytraps and boardwalks. Please do not step on small and fragile plants.
- Sugarloaf Trail**
This trail begins at the parking area and offers numerous distinctive views of the evergreen forest and cypress-gum swamp. The way to the Sugarloaf Dune and the Pre-Civil War grounds.
- Campground Trail**
The Campground Trail and briefly joins the Sugarloaf Trail through a coastal scrub community, dominated by threatened and endangered species.
- Sand Live Oak Trail**
This route takes you through the sand dune forest before coming to the beach. This trail is on US 421. Follow the yellow line.
- Snow's Cut Trail**
Snow's Cut Trail is a scenic route through a pine-land community along the Intracoastal Waterway. Along this trail there are views of the Intracoastal Waterway at the town's bike path.
- Carolina Beach Trail**
This section of the trail is a self-guided trail through the tidal cypress-gum swamp. Access to the trail is near the parking area.
- Swamp Trail**
This trail begins at the parking area and offers access to the grassy area and tidal cypress-gum swamp along either side of the Intracoastal Waterway.
- Oak Toe Trail**
Oak Toe Trail, which winds through the park, offers journeys to the beach and oak toe lichens. The Cape Fear River awaits. See fiddler crabs.
- Fitness Trail**
This pleasant walking trail through diverse habitats.
