

33rd ANNUAL MEMORIAL DAY RUN EGLIN AFB

4.4-Mile Run/Walk & Free Kids Run

Monday, May 28, 2018 Must be in place at 6:30 a.m. Race at 7 a.m.

Time, Location & Course:

Memorial Day Gate-to-Gate Run/Walk: Event is held at the corner of Chinquapin Dr. and Eglin Blvd, Eglin AFB. Participants must be in place at the starting line by 6:30 a.m. Wheelchairs start at 6:58 a.m. Runners start at 7 a.m. Walkers start at 7:02 a.m. Race will be held rain or shine. Runners/walkers must be finished by 9:30 a.m. or be escorted. The 4.4-mile course starts at Unity Park, follows Eglin Blvd. to Memorial Trail and ends at Unity Park. There will be flowers for each runner to drop at the Veterans' Memorial.

Parking: Parking will be at Unity Park. Please arrive early to park since participants must be in place at 6:30 a.m.

Team competition: 1st place trophies will be awarded to the top teams in open and military divisions in the 4.4 Run. There must be one female on the team to compete.

Competition Rules: Lowest accumulated time of the first four finishers for each team, which includes at least one of their female runners.

Open Division: Non-military units.

Military Division: Teams representing military units. All team members must be comprised of Active Duty, Reserve, Guard, DoD civilians, Contractors, or Spouses assigned to the unit to form a team.

Team Captains/Contacts: Each

team member must register individually on www.runsignup.com prior to the cutoff date for teams. Team captains must pick up a team roster form from the Eglin Fitness Center, or at www.eglinlife.com to identify team members. Team entry forms will also be available at at the Armament Museum on May 12th and 19th. All team members will be designated on the team roster by the team contact/captain. Team rosters must be turned into the Fitness Center by noon on May 21st. Changes to the team rosters will not be allowed after the package pickup at the Armament Museum.

Wheelchair Male & Female 1st place trophy Awards for the 4.4 mile run will also be given to the 1st-3rd place Male & Female runners in the following age groups: 1-9, 10-14, 15-19, 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, and 75+

Awards: 4.4-Mile Walk:

Special awards to the first overall male & female, the first Masters male & female (40+yrs), and the first Grand Master male & fe-male (50+yrs). Awards to the 1st-3rd place Male & Female walkers in the following age groups: 0-19, 20-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60-69, 70+

Kids Run: Run begins at 9 a.m. on Minor Rd. where the adult run starts and will proceed towards he control tower and then back. The Kids Run is FREE. No registration is required. Participation t-shirts will be given out at the end of the run. Trophies will be given to the overall male & female winners in the following groups: ages 5-6, 1/2-mile run; ages 7-8, 1-mile run; and, ages 9-12, 1-mile run.

Race Results: All race results will be posted at www.eventtiming.com and www.runsignup.com

Festivities: Enjoy FREE refreshments including food and assorted beverages. Beer will be available for purchase by ages 21 and over. Post-race party at the finish line will feature live entertainment.

Registration: All Participants will receive a quality T-Shirt. Registration is limited to the first 2,000 entries, so sign up early!

Early registration starts on Jan 22nd and ends on May 12th. Cost is \$25 and will be accepted online. Late online registration begins May 13th and runs through May 24th for DoD and May 13th-19th for Non-DoD participants or until the 2000th person signs up. Cost for late registration is \$30. Register at www.runsignup.com . An additional administrative fee will be charged. Online registration is strongly encouraged! On-line registration closes at 11:59 p.m. Central Time, May 24th or when the 2000th person signs up.

Eglin AFB Package Pick Up:

May 13th – 24th at the Eglin Fitness Center from 7 a.m. – 6 p.m. Photo ID required to pick up packages.

Late Package Pick Up: Saturday, May 19th, 10 a.m. - 3 p.m. at AF Armament Museum. Photo ID required picking up packages.

NO registration on Race Day!

Due to time constraints, it is HIGHLY recommended that participants pick up race packets prior to race day. Race packages can be picked up at Unity Park on race day from 5-6 a.m. only. Photo ID required to pick-up packages.

Important Information:

- Only day to enter in person with cash is May 12th at the AF Armament Museum.
- All participants and guests without valid base IDs MUST be preregistered and will enter the base through the HAUL RD GATE (see www.runsignup.com for details.)
 Restricted vehicle passes will be issued.
- Photo ID is mandatory for base access and for all package pickups.
- There will be NO refunds!
- Due to security issues, race is subject to change/cancellation.(i.e. Force Protection Measure changes)
- Race packages will not be mailed
- No skates, skateboards, or bicycles allowed on the course
- Participants that may be pregnant, consult with your physician before entering the race
- Strollers are welcome, but NO PETS!
- If you are picking up a package for another participant, a copy of a photo ID and a note of consent are required

The HAUL ROAD GATE is the mandatory gate for all NON-DoD ID card holders.

Directions:

From the North: Take Hwy 85 South to SR 387, follow the signs for Eglin AFB, and then follow the signs for Gate-to-Gate parking. All non-DoD prticipants must enter the base from the Haul Rd Gate.

From the West: Take Hwy 85 North or SR 189 to SR 387, follow the signs for Eglin AFB, and then follow the signs for Gate-to-Gate parking.

All Gate-to-Gate participants MUST preregister. All **DoD cardholder participants** enter from the **West Gate** for smooth traffic flow to race site. **Non-DoD participants** must enter through **Haul Rd Gate**.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR NON-DoD PERSONNEL AND GUEST:

Due to heightened security measures, Eglin AFB has changed their base access procedures. All persons gaining access to Eglin Air Force Base (EAFB) and materials are subject to search upon request by Security Forces (SF) personnel (ARRIVE EARLY). EAFB is a Federal installation and all Federal regulations apply as well as state and local laws. As such contraband items are not authorized on federal properties to include: firearms, open or concealed; knives with blades in excess of 3in in length; bludgeoning or any possible weapons of any type; explosives, ammunition, incendiaries or fireworks of any type; and no illegal drugs or drug paraphernalia. Also, limit backpacks or large hand carried items to minimally necessary. Please review below and provide requested information for race participation. In accordance with the Eglin Air Force Base Integrated Defense Plan Annex W, Section III, Chapter 1, all Non-DoD ID card holders will be checked (vetted) through the National Crime Information Center (NCIC) before being issued an installation entry pass or badge.

- Registration closes May 24th or when 2000th person registers.
- Non-DoD personnel and their guests must register online and submit Security Forces Affidavit to Eglin Welcome center in person or via USPS (postmarked no later than May 3rd) for their name to be on the list allowing entry at the Hall Gate the day of the race. Affidavits can be dropped off in person through May 21st at the East Gate Visitor Control Center (VCC) between 6 a.m. and 2 p.m. at the West Gate VCC from 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. or send it to:

- Due to security precautions, all Non-DoD personnel MUST enter the base from the HAUL RD GATE on race day only from 5 a.m. 6:15 a.m. Reminder that participants are to be in place by 6:30 a.m.
- Non-DoD personnel will be directed to and from the Unity Park by event security/marshals.
- Reminder that seat belts are required and phones must be used only with a hands-free device.

Disclosure of this information is voluntary; however, declining to submit required information will result in registrants and guests being denied access to Eglin AFB.
