

Frequently Ask Question (FAQ)

Refund

No refund, transfer or deferment for all race entries. If you cannot participate you may still pick up your packet after the race or by contacting the Detroit Parks & Recreation Department at (313) 224-1100.

Strollers

We do allow people to run/walk with baby joggers or strollers, but must start in the back of the pack for your safety and safety of others.

Toilets

Portable Toilets will be accessible at the start/finish line.

Parking

Parking is available in the Brennan Pool parking lot off of Plymouth Rd. The Detroit Parks & Recreation Department, City of Detroit and its sponsorship are not responsible for damage or theft of vehicles or personal belongings. Park at your own risk.

Water

Water station will be available near the start/finish line and along the race route starting at Joy Rd. and Spinoza.

First Aid/Medical Support

First Aid stations will be setup near the start/finish line and along the race route starting at Joy Rd. and Spinoza. In addition Emergency Medical personnel will be available along the race route.

Gear Check

No gear check will be available. Detroit Parks & Recreation Department, its sponsors or affiliates will not be responsible for lost or stolen personal items.

Inclement Weather

In the event of heavy rain, lightening or other inclement weather the event will be delayed. The event will not be postponed until another day.

Should the inclement weather persist for more than an hour the event will be cancel. If the rain occurs after the start of the race, you are advised to seek sheltered. If you wish to continue with the race you do so at your own risk.

NO refund will be issued if event is cancelled for act of nature.

Medals

Event medals will be given to all registered participant of the STAY Fit For Health Event.

Start/Finish Line

Start/Finish Line is located at Spinoza and Brennan Pool Drive for the 3K/5K. For the Fun Run the start/finish line is located southeast of Brennan Pool.

Dogs

Animals are allowed to participate with registered participants in the walk events only, however they must remain leashed at all times and registered. You must start in the back of the pack and you will be responsible for the clean-up.

Deadline for Registration

Early Bird registration ends June 1. Late registration starts June 2. Last day to register is July 22.

Distance

5K = 3.81 Miles, 3K = 1.86 Miles, Fun Run = $\frac{1}{2}$ mile
