| Entry | \$15 till ten days prior, then \$20 online. Day-of entry is \$25. No mail-in. No checks. Pick any events for one fee. We plan to take credit cards at the event – see web site to confirm. <i>35% discount for PAC members – online only.</i> Event crew for May 25 + June track series – help at one meet, get a free entry (transferable) for next meet. | Events | Check web site. Track events begin at 5:50 with slowest distance heat. Order is distance, 400, sprint, 800, relay. FAT (fully automatic timing) by Tomahawk Timing*. Distance is 1500 to 3200. Sprint is 100 or 200. Relay is typically 4x400. Heats determined event day. Events will run continuously. Relays may be formed on the day. Sprinters... BYO Blocks. *Slow distance heat may be hand timed. | Field events begin at 5:30. Shot put followed by long jump. Will run concurrently if sufficient crew. 3 or 4 attempts, subject to number of entries. No finals. Throwers... BYO shots. Limited selection of youth weights may be available. Triple jump or high jump may be added, <i>depending on level of volunteer support.</i> |
