### Official Race Rules

**SWIM** - Swimmers must wear the official swim cap provided for safety and identification of the wave assignment. Swimmers who request assistance from race personnel will not be allowed to continue the race.

**BIKE** - NO DRAFTING ALLOWED! You will be IMMEDIATELY DISQUALIFIED for an obvious drafting violation. All participants must obey all local traffic laws and the directions of race officials. Competitors will be biking on public roads and must ride on the road shoulder.

Helmets are MANDATORY for all participants and must comply with the CPSC federal standard.

**RUN** - The runner must stay on the course (road shoulder), and follow the directions of all race officials and volunteers.

Event promoters have the right to alter event if dictated by weather or other conditions.

Absolutely no entry fee, or portion of entry fee can be refunded, transferred or credited.
