Start: On Violet at the sixth guard rail post on the left (south side of the road counting eastward from the Parkview school access road.


Mile 1: On Violet Terrace after running the first small loop, 3 feet 11 inches before the gas valve cap in front of house #22 on the left.

Halfway: On South Brook, at the center of the manhole in the middle of the street at the trailing edge of the driveway to house #59 on the left.

Mile 2: On South Brook before the turn onto Albert, 6 feet 5 inches after the fire hydrant on the right at house #6 which is on the right.

Mile 3: On J F Kennedy, 14 feet 2 inches before utility pole BT390BM on the right.

Finish: On JF Kennedy, at utility pole B3394BM on the right.
