Thank you for participating in the **2023 Tricia Davis 5K for Sinai House!** We are so pleased to gather again in person at Rock Creek Park to celebrate Tricia Davis. She was committed to combating homelessness and housing insecurity and used the energy, excitement, and passion that she brought to everything she did in life toward the establishment and longevity of Sinai House. Your participation in the Tricia Davis 5K carries on Tricia's legacy and supports Sinai House in its mission to enable families to move

from homelessness to independence by providing safe and affordable housing, comprehensive social services, and financial support. Our community is supported by an all-volunteer Board of Directors, Temple Sinai members, Temple clergy, the Sinai House staff and professional consultants, and volunteers who tutor, mentor and plan activities for our current and former residents.

This has been a challenging and exciting year, as we transitioned from providing all our services virtually during the height of the pandemic, to increasingly meeting with our residents in person once again. Three families are now in their second and final year of our new post-residency program. After extensive maintenance and repairs to our 100-year-old buildings, we welcomed four new families to the Sinai House residency program. One of those families has now departed, and a young mother who recently came from South Africa with a two-year-old daughter, eager to take advantage of Sinai House services, became our newest resident in late February. As a result of this important work, we need to replenish our Commitment Fund, which provides the financial backing we need to guarantee our commitment to our Sinai House resident and alumni families.

#### **Race Details**

The 5K race begins and finishes at Rock Creek Park in Washington, DC at Picnic Area #24 in the Carter Barron parking lot and has one turn-around point. There will be a water station at the Start/Finish line and one along the race route. A bag drop will be available. Strollers and dogs are welcome, but please stay toward the back of the pack while lining up. Dogs must be on a 3' non-extendible leash. Join or create a **Social Race Team** and invite as many friends and family members as you want to register and walk or run together for fun.

#### Children, Strollers & Dogs

Strollers and dogs are welcome, but please stay toward the back of the pack while lining up. Dogs must be on a 3' non-extendible leash. You do not have to register your dog.

#### **Parking**

Ample, free parking is available at the Carter Barron Amphitheatre parking lot. Please enter the parking lot from Colorado Avenue (from 16<sup>th</sup> Street) to park near Picnic Grove #24, near the entrance to the Tennis Center. If you are using a GPS, use the Tennis Center's address:

#### Race Bib & T-Shirt Pick-Up

Two times and locations to pick up your race bib and T-shirt:

- Saturday, May 13<sup>th</sup> from 3 4:30 in the Temple Sinai Parking lot at 3100 Military Road NW, Washington, DC.
- Sunday, May 8<sup>th</sup> from 7 7:30 am at the race site on race day.

Participants who registered for the 5K event will receive a race bib with an RFID disposable "bib-timing chip" attached. Fun Run participants will receive a race bib without a timing chip attached. Virtual Participants receive a T-shirt, but no racing bib.
