Handicap parking will be available at the school. There is NO PARKING in the Dialysis Center parking lot, as they will be seeing patients. Carpooling is highly recommended!

Race begins promptly at 9:00 AM. Awards will follow immediately after the race finishes. We are expecting more than 3,200 participants, so *please ask your team members to allow enough time to arrive at St. Peter's no later than 8:15 AM*.
