Benefits of Becoming a Volunteer

Become a one-day volunteer with the oldest and largest civic organization in the world – Rotary International! No experience is required. As a volunteer you will meet new friends, have fun and know you have contributed to your community by assisting the Rotary Club of Woodridge in raising funds to help support projects in Woodridge and worldwide for those in need.

This year due to Covid-19 impacts, the event is limited to the Main Event (12 years of age and older) and expect 300-500 athletes. Past events registered 700+ athletes coming from over 120 different communities and several surrounding states. Add in the 100+ volunteers and hundreds of spectators, makes for a great regional event.

The event officially starts with athlete check-in at 5:30 AM. The Main Race starts at 7AM and typically is complete by 9:30AM.

Volunteer positions were assigned on a first come, first serve basis or as determined by the Race Director to best serve the needs of the event. The Woodridge Rotary Club acknowledges and thanks all volunteers for their dedication, time and continued support. All volunteers must complete and sign the volunteer form and waiver attached hereto. Volunteers under 18 years of age must have parental/guardian consent.

General Information (UPDATED INFORMATION)

Each volunteer is critical to the smooth operation of the day's event and for creating a positive, fun experience for all who participate.

A volunteer information meeting will NOT be held this year. Supervisors will contact you to review general event information, detail volunteer responsibilities, and answer volunteer questions. Safety vests, Race Crew t-shirts and other equipment will be handed out at Volunteer Check-in the morning of the event (8/8/21). All volunteers must check-in day of the event at the Woodridge Park District Athletic Recreation Center (ARC), 8201 Janes Avenue, on the northeast corner of 83rd Street & Janes Avenue. If you are stationed out on the course (Bike & Run Routes Only), after you check in at the ARC and after you post at your location you must contact the Volunteer Coordinator by calling Suzy Chudzik (Phone #: (630) 251-6104) to confirm your posting.

Refer to Volunteer spreadsheet posted week of the event for volunteers assignments and parking locations day of the event. See Exhibit 'A' for parking locations.

Read the attached event flier description to learn as much as you can about the race and your volunteer areas through the information provided. Volunteers must wear their assigned safety vest.

Dress comfortably for the area you are assigned to work in and make sure to wear sunscreen. Bring plenty of water/liquids/snacks with you if you are assigned out on the course and bring a chair. **Bring cell phone to call for any needs to contact your supervisor and emergency medical services.** In case of a medical emergency, contact 9-1-1 for immediate assistance. EMS will be stationed at various areas throughout the course

Focus on being helpful to all our guests, smile and be courteous at all times. **CHEER ON THE ATHLETES!!!**Most importantly attend to your assigned duties! Contact your Supervisor to assist when needed.

Do not leave your post until instructed by your Supervisor.

As a token of our appreciation, each volunteer will receive a Race Crew event T-shirt (pick up at check-in) and a Food & Beverage good for the day of the event. Food & Beverage includes a packaged snacks, water or sport drink.

Pre-Event Volunteers

<u>Pre-Event Set Up/Post Event Take Down</u>: Volunteers are required for Saturday in three different shifts, 8AM – Noon, Noon – 4PM and 4PM – 8PM at Cypress Cove Family Aquatic Park for event set-up.

A minimum of ten (10) volunteers are required for each shift. Duties involved are setting up course signage, banners, registration tables, tents, water/snack tables, filling water coolers, delivering equipment to on-site locations, setting up bike racks in transition area, spectator barricades, setting up garbage receptacles, traffic cones, etc.

<u>Pre-Event Packet Pick-Up</u>: Volunteers are required for both Friday evening from 4:00PM to 8PM and Saturday morning shift 8:45AM – Noon and afternoon shift from Noon – 3PM at the Woodridge Park District Athletic Recreation Center (ARC), 8201 Janes Avenue, Woodridge, IL 60517.

A minimum of four (4) volunteers are required for each shift. Responsibilities sorting t-shirts into sizes and checking-in athletes that pick up their t-shirt and race packets.

Post Event Volunteers

<u>Post-Event Take Down</u>: Volunteers are required Sunday 10:00AM – 11:30AM at Cypress Cove Family Aquatic Park.

A minimum of ten (10) volunteers are required. Duties involved are taking down course signage, registration tables, tents, water/snack tables, water coolers, bike racks, barricades, garbage receptacles, cleaning up litter/debris, traffic cones, etc.

Emergency Medical Procedures

Emergency Incident Command Unit

Staffed by Woodridge Police, local Fire Departments, Village of Woodridge Public Works, Woodridge Park District, and Rotary Event Personnel, a Emergency Incident Command Unit (CICU) will be established off-site to coordinate all emergency and logistical communications. Volunteer Supervisors will be provided with two-way-radios and cell phone numbers to report any needs of assistance to the CICU. Volunteers shall report to their immediate supervisors any situations needing assistance.

First Aid Services & Procedures

Cypress Cove Management and Life Guard staff trained in CPR and First Aid will be on site to assist in situations of any individual that experience health problems or injury. See volunteer notification protocols below:

Main Site Location:

Course Marshall Volunteers located on the main site will be provided with a whistle. If an athlete needs non-life threatening first aid, volunteer shall blow two (2) short whistles. If an athlete is in need of emergency medical services the volunteer shall blow three (3) short consecutive whistles. A paramedic unit is located on the premises and should be made aware of any first aid/medical situation by any volunteer, Supervisor and/or the Asst. Director. If the paramedic unit is not on-site any volunteer shall call 9-1-1 first,

and also call with a two-way-radio to Emergency Incident Command to report the need for EMS. Other volunteers shall assist by standing at their current location and point to where the athlete in need is located to direct EMS to the location.

Off Site Locations:

Volunteers located on the course routes shall call 9-1-1 for emergency medical needs. Volunteer shall give location (cross streets & benchmarks). Following 9-1-1 the volunteer shall call their supervisor to report the incident.

Duties: check-in all athletes on registration listing and hand out t-shirt & BIB # packet. A pair of volunteers will be assigned to three (3) different check-in areas according to the athletes names (A-I), (J-R) and (S-Z). One volunteer shall check in the athlete and the other shall gather and hand out the t-shirt/BIB #. Instruct athletes to place their BIB numbers on the front of their clothing and instruct athlete to find Body Marking Assistants to assist with putting on athletes BIB # Tattoos. Direct the athletes to the transition area.

Special Event Notes: **No walk up registration day of the event is permitted!** Official check-in of athletes for the Main Race begins at 5:30AM. Athletes registered for the team relay, will be assigned one BIB number to be worn by the runner. BIB # tattoos to be worn by the swimmer, and Bike/Helmet BIB # stickers worn by the biker. Direct athletes to bike transition area and find volunteers to assist with placing on Body Marking BIB # tattoos.

Shift End: duties end after the Main Race starts approximately 8:00 AM.

Duties: instruct athletes that have their BIB # to go straight into the transition zone following opening at 5:30AM for Main Event. Direct athletes that didn't pre-pick up their T-shirt/BIB # packet to check-in at the Late Check-in tables located in the pre/post event area and answer any general event questions. Note only athletes w/ BIB #'s and parents/guardians w/ a designated wrist band may enter into the transition zone. Body Marking Assistants will be located at the Late Registration Tent and in Transition to assist athletes in placing the BIB # tattoos on their right bicep and right calf.

Special Event Notes: See Special Event Notes under Athlete Check-in Attendants. Must be knowledgeable of event and general rules. Race teams with tents to be located in grass area between pre/post event area and the run finish line. Refer to Athlete Race Information Q&A on the website for detailed race information.

Check-in Time: 5:00AM. Check-in and pick up volunteer safety vest at Woodridge ARC.

Post Time: Main Event - 5:15AM

Shift End: duties end after the Main Race starts at 7:30AM, however you may assigned to different area. **Duties**: Apply BIB # tattoos to athlete's right outer bicep and right calf. Tattoo application instructions: 1) Remove protective clear top sheet from tattoo. 2) Place tattoo with the paper backing side up, press tattoo onto skin with ink design facing skin. 3) Hold wet paper towel / wash cloth to the paper back of tattoo, hold and make sure to wet it all the way through the white backer paper, & wait 40 seconds (don't hurry). 4) Peel off paper backing slowly and carefully. Instruct athletes to place (pin) their BIB number on the front of their clothing or race belt and sticker BIB #'s on their bike cross bar & helmet.

If tattoo fails use large Sharpie Marker to right BIB # on body as instructed above.

Special Notes: Most Body Marking Assistants will repost to Transition Course Marshalls (refer to Volunteer Assignment Spreadsheet for reposting details). Assist with keeping transition areas clear of other athletes and debris during race. Assist in transitioning adult bike racks to kid bike racks between races.

Director of Bike Logistics will inform you when shift ends and to relocate.

of Volunteers Reg'd.: twenty-one (22) volunteer positions are needed.

Duties: direct bikers on designated route to stay on course. Report (write down BIB # or physical description) any bikers that try to short cut the bike route immediately to Mike Adams @ 630/558-4656.

Special Notes: Report to Supervisor or Race Director the BIB # of any biker that does not have their helmet chin strap buckled while biking on the course or who is aggressively/intentionally cutting off other bikers or riding in an unsafe manner.

General rules: bikers shall keep at least three bike lengths of clear space between the cyclist in front. Headphones, headsets, walkmans, ipods, mp3 players, or personal audio devices, etc. are not to be carried or worn at any time during the bike segment of the race.

Shift End: duties end after the Main Race approximately 9:30 AM **# of Volunteers Reg'd**.: nine (9) volunteers are needed for this position.

Duties: provide information to athletes as needed, bike rack positions are available on first come first save basis once transition zone is opened, Ensure only four (4) bikes per rack with bike positions alternating on each side of rack with the seat of the bike placed on the rack bar. Keep spectators out from transition area / only athletes with BIB #'s, volunteers with Rotary safety vest or parents/guardians with special wrist band are permitted in transition zone. Keep transition lane areas clear from any obstructions/other athletes. Pick up debris/garbage that may pose a safety risk and instruct athletes with directions of where to go to starts for both bike and run. Instruct all participants that they must return their bicycles to an upright position in their designated bicycle corral/position.

Special Notes: Volunteers in bike acceleration/deceleration zone must instruct bikers to dismount in deceleration zone. **No riding in transition zone – violators may be disqualified.** Report violators promptly to Supervisor by their BIB#. Athletes may draw on pavement with chalk to help identify their bike rack location.

Items attached to the bike rack that obstruct other athletes is prohibited and shall be removed upon notification. Helmets are required to be on and fastened before they remove their bike from the bike rack. Athletes without a helmet are strictly prohibited from access the bike course. Violators will be DQ'd.

Duties: place fruit/snacks on table (do not cut fruit to prevent bugs/flies). Place water bottles & sport drinks in separate troughs, get ice machine key and cart from Race Director on Race Day morning, retrieve ice from Home City ice machine next to Cypress Cove Bathhouse. Limit distribution of fruit/snacks to one/two per athlete (no hording). Oversee general area, clean up garbage and replenish supplies as needed.

Special Notes: for emergency assistance blow provided whistle three long blows to alert on site EMS or call 9-1-1.
