**COURSE:** Each 1.5-mile lap will incorporate sections of grass, dirt, crushed gravel, barrier sections, and staircases.

FINE PRINT: HELMETS ARE REQUIRED FOR CYCLOCROSS PARTCIPATION. Race runs rain or shine. NO REFUNDS. All USA Cycling rules apply. CYCLOCROSS racers must provide a valid USA Cycling annual license at registration or will be required to purchase a one-day license at the event (\$10). Parent or guardian of those under 18 will be required to sign, no exceptions. Cyclocross racing age is your age as of DECEMBER 31, 2018. Cyclocross racers from outside the U.S. must show a valid UCI license or purchase a one-day license. No bar ends or clip on aero bars allowed. Winners must show identification to claim prize money. 15-minute protest period for results.
