

What to expect for 2016:


- Same size field (sign up early, as it will probably close out in a day)


1. HALF MARATHON MAP







2. JANIT FROM NEWSLETTER #1 HUMAN INTEREST STORY:

Mark your calendar for January 1 2016 at noon!! Why? Because this is the date, day and time when you will be able to sign up for the 5th annual "Run for the Cows" in W. Redding, Connecticut. Seriously, do it!!

I was one of the fortunate runners to do so on January 1 as the races sold out in four hours. There is a half marathon (13.1miles), a 7 miler, and a kids'race of less than a mile. All of these runners converge on the huge and scenic New Pond Farm

in the bucolic town of West Redding, Connecticut. West Redding is located @ 70miles north of NYC, 20miles southeast of Danbury, CT and 70 miles west of Hartford, CT.

This set and organization of races accommodated runners from 22 states this year. Word has gotten out in the running community and this is not a race to be missed. It does not matter which distance you choose or prefer, it is the way the Race Director, John McCleary organizes and orchestrates the whole operation. Everything little detail is superb from the parking in a huge open field with neat rows of cars with spaces for you to exit to friendly volunteers who will direct you. I have been to so many races where it appears that the volunteers do not have a "clue" about what they are suppose to do or better still, they are staring at their SmartPhones with their heads down. But nonetheless, John instructs his volunteers in the aspects of customer service and their friendliness makes you feel welcome when you drive into the open fields.

Secondly, the registration tables were organized and efficient. There were different tables for each of the 3 races with perky and efficient ladies who honestly were efficient. They could have worked for L.L. Bean as their caring attitudes shown through. AND the race numbers were personalized with each of the runner's first name on the bottom. If you were early enough in the race registration process, you could even choose your own number. I chose my sister's birthday and this would be meaningful for her and for me even though the race was held in May. I will be sending my sister my race # in her birthday card for August 13th. My race # was 813 (8/13).

The races had different starting times and the slower half marathoners were able to start at 7:20am so they could finish with most of the other half marathoners and join in on the celebration. The half marathoners started at 8am and the 7mile runners at 8:35am. I did not see the kids' race but I think it was after the 7 mile race went off.

This was carefully conceived by John, the race director so to accommodate all of the runners in their quest for either a PR or for an individual acceptable time. Each race had its own start with a countdown of 10 minutes, and so on. I was able to watch the start of the half marathon from a stone wall that surrounded the perimeter of the first 2 miles of the course. It was a glorious sight to see so many runners in single file running over rolling hills with smiles on their faces greeted by the crowd of onlookers. The 7 mile race started as planned at 8:35am. John

came down into the pack of runners and gave us an accurate course description of the seven miles, mile by mile, five minutes before the race started. All of runners were very appreciative of this personal touch. Usually race directors are frantic just before a race starts, but NOT john. He was very calm knowing full well that he had done his homework as his efficiency shown though.

All along the course, the volunteers were encouraging. Every mile was marked with signs on in huge numbers that you could not miss. Several of the more difficult miles had signs like, "Remember You Paid for This Race", "Remember, You're Doing This for a Free Banana", "Only One More Mile to Go" and "MOOve Over." You had to laugh at the artist's thoughtful and comical signage and I smiled at the cow faces with regularity. Two weeks later I still remember them.

The finish line was quite unique in that we ran though barn doors to the digital clock and finish pads. It was memorable in the sense that the crowds were still there and cheering for every runner. The medals were magnificent in the shape of a cowbell. The volunteers who handed out the water bottles and the medals did not rush anyone and there was plenty of room for runners to greet their families and to walk around and/or sit. Many times runners stack up at the finish and pile up on each other in the chutes. Not here!! There was plenty of space and room to move through the chutes.

The refreshments were also thoughtful with cold chocolate milk being one of the offerings. After all we were on a farm and the cows were watching us. We were on their turf. There was also water, juice, coffee, carbonated water, and soda of many varieties. Plenty of fruit, breads, homemade cookies, donuts, bagels and assortments of peanut butter, cream cheese, butter and jellies served the individual runner's delights. No one went home hungry.

There was an expo of sorts with several area businesses with free samples and giveaways nearby. This was a good way to stretch your legs after the race and to mingle with the vendors. The vendors were all pleasant, not pushy and loved talking about their products and offerings. You could tell that John, the race director had conversed with them individually before the race and all of them seemed pleased at the turnout and the runners' interest in their displays.


Of note were the efficient results and the award ceremony. It seemed to occur right when it was announced that it would happen!! How many times have you been to a race and it is announced that the awards ceremony would be in 10

minutes? 10 minutes go by, 20 minutes slide and some runners begin the leave. Not here!! The awards happened when announced. Each winner (top three and then age groups with top three male and female) was announced and greeted by the owner of the New Pond Farm. Each winner was warmly greeted and thanked for coming to the race. And the cutest touches were the awards. Each 1st age group winner was given a set of glasses and a pitcher with the New Pond Farm logo on the glassware, along with a plaque with an attachment of a coat hook. I put mine in the garage so I can hang up my winter coats that I wear for shoveling snow. Very thoughtful and useful prizes. At this point, I also comment on the "swag" given to every runner as in John's book, every runner counts. We all received a blue technical shirt with the New Pond Farm logo on it. You got the size you requested which shows that volunteers had to match up the sizes with the individual names. A sizeable feat for this large crowd too. Additionally we received a great refrigerator magnet, an insulated picnic bag with a coffee mug and water bottle inside, a cowbell of course and a few other pens, etc. All memorable and useful and appreciated by someone who had thought this through. I think much of that credit goes to the Race Director and his committee.

The results were posted by the time I arrived back home at 1pm. And there were follow up emails thanking the participants. I felt genuinely appreciated to be at such an efficient race. Beforehand, I had several emails with questions for John. He answered them within 5 minutes and in a personal manner. He kept runners up to date months ahead of the race with his newsletters and articles about educational opportunities at the New Pond Farm. After all, this was a "Race for the Cows" and the farm serves as a learning opportunity for all. It is a gorgeous facility to be admired if you have the chance. It is family friendly where you can visit with the cows and other farm animals. There is a section of a pond with ducks, swans and chickens to little (and big) kids' delights. Go for the race and save time for a tour of the New Pond Farm. The beauty of the setting, the farm and its offerings will amaze you. The efficiency and thoughtfulness of John McCleary will spoil you so that you will want to do this race again and again!! Races like "Run for the Cows" are memorable and spectacular. It does not get much better than this!! On a scale of 1 to 10, this one gets a 14!!!!

3. WARD CARPENTER RACE BLOG (2014):

Racing for the Cows can be fun!



A question among the runners was, "Is this the OFFICIAL COW that we are racing for"?



Then again, there were other cows there..... and another cow along the course around mile 8 but that's for later...

But seriously, aLL the cows and chickens and goats and sheep and other farm animals at New Pond Farm in Redding, CT benefited from the 3rd Annual "Race for the Cows" Half Marathon and 7 miler run. I don't know how John McCleary, the Race Director, does it every year but once again, the weather was just spot on for the race. Start time temperature was 49 degrees with nice sunshine and some minor clouds along the route to keep you from getting too warm.

Talk about wonderful pre-race staging, they had tons of food and HOT COFFEE and massages (yes massages) for the runners as they waited for the start of the half marathon at 8:00 AM under the tent. Of course, a critical item for the runners, 25 port-a-lets near the tents!!



The DJ had the music cranked up and you could just feel the energy build as we got closer to the start. The early starters (those expecting over 2:30:00 finish times) left at 7:15 AM to the cheers of the other runners. The half marathon parking filled up the meadow early on (hint, get there early for good parking spots!!)



As we got close to the 8AM start time, the runners assembled at the starting point. At 7:50, Eowyn Driscoll did an amazing job singing the National Anthem. I was up on the hill doing a warm up jog and her voice just echoed across the entire farm. Very very cool.





True to his word, John started the race exactly at 8AM and we were off! The first half mile or so takes you around that beautiful meadow and back past the starting point before you head out on the roads.

Once you leave New Pond Farms, you turn left and head down the hill and take another left onto the back roads of Redding.




I ran this race last year but I had forgotten just how hilly the first 3 or 4 miles are. Fair warning to first time half marathon runners, this is NOT an easy course (not to scare you away, just make you aware you WILL find hills and hills and hills and.. well... hills)! The route is beautiful with many things to distract you as you run.





Wait, what? Um., what IS this creature???

Once you reach the top of what you will think is the steepest hill you have run (outside of trail running), you are greeted by this beautiful dirt road that seems to be flat!



Finally, you get down hill and flat for about 4 or 5 miles! This is such a wonderful thing! I love the sign along the route as you begin a very serious down hill run on a dirt road that said something like 'Be thankful your race director had you going in the direction you are going' implying that the other direction uphill would kill you (and yes, it would!).

The course actually loops back on itself and puts you on the Simpaug Turnpike for a few miles. This blessed FLAT section allows you to recover from the downhill part of the run and regroup. As I ran this section, off in the distance, I could see a cow waving to me! Yes, really!



Moo Totally impressed!

The road parallels the Metro North train tracks and after some time, we take a hard left over the tracks and begin what I consider the third half of the half So far, we had a hilly start, a flat middle, and now we face more hills. You work your way up and down and up and up and up to Topstone Park where you take a right and run the small trail that takes you to the lakes edge and then loop back to the road. Here you return DOWNHILL for a spell (it feels SO good) and pass those runners who are still working their way to the park. By now, you are around mile 11.5 or so (sorry, I can't be more precise) and you work more hills. Then a blessed down hill and you pick up Marchant Road to return to New Pond Farm. Save something in the tank as you have two more hills to overcome before that last downhill and left turn to run through the barn and to the finish line!

Course Support was fantastic! The aid stations were at just the right places and the teams volunteering to help were wonderful. Water, sports drink, and orange slices around mile 9.5 (wow, were they good) as well as candy and wet sponges (not to be eaten 49) at Topstone Park.

The post race food was great! Pizza (sooo good), water, snacks, ICE CONES, coffee, etc. John and his team of volunteers did such a good job this year (the first two years tool).

Bling. Did I mention Bling? The stuff you get for registering is great. Very cool shirt, coffee cup, plastic cup, mason jar, insulated snack bag, chap stick, I am sure I am forgetting half of it (I forgot to take a picture of everything).

I have to say, it was just a fantastic race (again). I hurt in places I didn't know I could hurt (wait, that suggests I could have been more prepared? Well, maybe loosing a few pounds and doing my core workouts would make a HUGE difference .. lol). Okay, time to make that into action. My next half marathon is the Fairfield Half Marathon on June 22nd. That does give me enough time to see what a difference 5 lbs and core workouts can do. (just have to be ready for the heat and humidity)
