What do you need to take with you?

- Sport outfit
- Hockey stick (only if you have your own. We have plenty!!)
- Drinking bottle
- Hockey shoes
- Shin pads
- Lunch and healthy snacks
- Mouth guard
- Swimsuit (We have the pool booked for 2 lunch time sessions)
- Towel
- Dry sport outfit
- Medications (inclusive of Asthma Pumps)
- Sunscreen
- Hat/Cap (not to be worn during games)

We strongly advice you to wear a mouth guard and shin pads for your own health and safety.

It is wise to make sure that you are in a good physical condition before the camp starts, also try to do some exercises (because for many it will be a while since they have last touched a hockey stick....).

- * We ask you to keep in mind that SportWays camps are 'sport'camps. This means smoking and/or drinking alcohol is NOT allowed.
- * Lost items can be collected at the end of the camp. Uncollected lost items will stay with the Bermuda Hockey Federation for later pick-ups, items not collected after 7 days will be disposed.
- * If you are on medication and need to take prescription medicine during the day please inform the staff about this.

Special note for Goalies - Goalies need to bring their own equipment, there are no hand protectors or body protectors at the camp. We advise to bring extra tape and straps.
