COURSE DESCRIPTION – 10 Mile and 5 Mile

- Start/Finish is in the front parking lot of College Station High School
- Proceed from start/finish heading out toward Barron Rd.
- Turn right on Barron Rd.
- Turn left on Victoria Ave.
- Turn right down bike trail just past Hasselt St.
- Continue right on bike trail to Graham Rd
- Turn Left on Graham Rd
- Turn Right on Longmire Dr.
- Turn Right on Barron Rd.
- Left on Victoria Ave.
- Right into parking lot.
- 5 mile runners proceed to finish line, 10 mile runners take chute to start 2nd loop
- Proceed past turn to begin your second loop to complete 10 miles.

COURSE DESCRIPTION – 5k Course

- Start/Finish is in the front parking lot of College Station High School
- Proceed from start/finish heading out toward Barron Rd.
- Turn right on Barron Rd.
- Turn left on Victoria Ave.
- Turn right on Eagle
- Turn Right on Longmire Dr.
- Turn Right on Barron Rd.
- Left on Victoria Ave.
- Right into parking lot.
- 5 mile runners proceed to finish line, 10 mile runners take chute to start 2nd loop
- Proceed past turn to begin your second loop to complete 10 miles.



PARKING & DIRECTIONS

From Houston:

Take US Highway 290 West toward Austin. Travel through Hockley, Waller, and Prairie View toward Hempstead. Take the Texas Highway 6 North exit toward Bryan/College Station. Travel approximately 40 miles through Navasota to College Station. Take the Barron Rd exit. Turn left on Barron Rd, then right on Victoria Ave. Destination will be on the right.

From Dallas:

Take I-45 South toward Ennis and Houston. Travel through Ennis, Corsicana, Fairfield, and Centerville approximately 130 miles to exit 152 toward OSR, Normangee. Turn left onto FM 39 Rd. Turn right onto Highway 21 W for 22 miles. Turn left onto Earl Rudder Fwy toward Houston. Merge onto TX-6 S. Take exit toward Barron Rd. Take a right on Barron, then left on Victoria Ave. Destination will be on the right.

From Austin:

From I-35, take US-290 East.

Travel through Manor and Elgin toward Houston approximately 38 miles. Before Paige, turn left onto Texas Highway 21 East. Travel toward Caldwell, Bryan and College Station approximately 53 miles. Before Smetana, merge onto Texas Highway 47 South. Travel approximately 6 miles and merge onto FM-60 East/Raymond Stotzer Pkwy. Turn right on Harvey Mitchell Pkwy S (FM 2818). Exit onto FM 2154 S/Wellborn Rd. Turn Left onto Graham Rd, then right on Victoria Ave. Destination will be on your right.

From San Antonio:

Take I-35 north to San Marcos. Take Exit 205 (State Rte 21 toward Bastrop/Luling). Past Bastrop, look for left turn to continue on Highway 21 toward Caldwell (after left turn, will travel approx 3 blocks and turn right to continue on Highway 21). Continue northeast on Highway 21 to Highway 47 (on outskirts of Bryan near Texas A&M Riverside Campus). You will exit to the right onto Highway 47. Head east on Highway 47. As you near College Station, Hwy 47 curves strongly to the left, and you will enter Raymond Stotzer Parkway (FM 60). Continue on Raymond Stotzer Pkwy (FM 60) past the airport. Turn right onto Harvey Mitchell Parkway (FM 2818). Exit onto FM 2154 S/Wellborn Rd. Turn Left onto Graham Rd, then right on Victoria Ave. Destination will be on your right.

WATER STOPS

There will be water stops at miles 1.5/6.5, 3/8, and 4.5/9.5 along the course. Each stop will provide Gatorade and Water. Water Stops are self serve.

Gatorade Endurance will be served in Gatorade cups and water in the white cups. Gatorade will be first at the water stop, followed by water.

We encourage all runners to maintain and practice proper hydration throughout their training and participation within the event.



POST RACE FINISH FESTIVAL

WELCOME BACK All runners will be treated to a post race food line. Breakfast tacos, bananas, and granola bars are just some of the items included in our post race food. There will be water and soft drinks available courtesy of Texas 10 Race Management.

During the Finish Festival we will **give away five \$100 bills** to random 10-mile finishers and **four \$50 bills** to random 5-mile finishers via a drawing. One 5ker will walk away with **one \$50 bill**. One club will walk away with **\$250** for the most runners in attendance.

FINISHER MEDALS & AWARDS

AWARDS CEREMONY – LIVE

All finishers in the 10-mile, 5-mile and 5k will receive a finisher medal when they complete their race.

The 10-mile overall male and female winners will receive a cash prize of \$150 each and the fastest 5-mile split in the 10-mile (male and female) will receive \$75 each.

The first three finishers in the following age groups (see below) will be awarded prizes in the 10-mile, 5-mile and 5k races.

ARMADILLO CUP



The race for the 2021-22 Armadillo Cup continues in College Station. College Station is a 19-point race and the 5th race in the Series and is run on a fast, wide-open two loop course. Each finisher in the 10-mile race will receive a minimum of ten (10) points.

TEN GALLON CUP

The Ten Gallon Club Cup is a competition encouraging running clubs; groups or organizations to participate in the Texas 10 Series run distances. The overall total for all runners in the club, group or organization in the 10 mile, 5 mile and 5k will be figured based on total number of finishers.

FAQs

Q: Can I run with a baby jogger, skateboard, bike or dog?

A: Yes. In consideration for the safety of all participants, runners with baby joggers are requested to be mindful on the 5k, 5-mile and 10-mile courses.

Q: Can I run with headphones?

A: Headphones are not prohibited but are strongly discouraged. Participants who wear headphones must remain aware of safety vehicles, race officials, traffic and other runners. Any participant who fails to follow directions from race officials is subject to being removed from the race course, for their own safety and the safety of other participants.

Q: What is the time limit for a Texas 10 Series race?

A: All streets must be reopened to traffic by 10:15 a.m. and all participants must be able to cross the Finish Line by 10:00 a.m. to be recorded as an official finisher. No refunds will be given for registered participants who are directed off the course due to pace. No exceptions. Support and Gear (SAG) Wagons and equipment trucks will follow the last participants to move slower runners to the side of road and reopen the streets as necessary. These participants will not be able to finish the race or receive their medal.

Q: Do I need a qualifying time to participate?

A: No, there is no qualifying time to participate in Texas 10 Series events.

Q: Can I walk?

A: Yes, if you are able to finish by 10:00 a.m.

Q: How many water stations will you have?

A: There will be three (3) hydration/water stations along the course and one (1) at the Finish Line.

Q: When will Armadillo and Ten Gallon Club Cup receive their cash award payments?

A: Texas 10 Race Management will issue award checks at the Cup Championship Party in April or early May.

FAQs cont.

Q: When will Armadillo and Ten Gallon Cup receive their cash award payments?

A: Texas 10 Race Management will issue award checks 6 to 8 weeks after the event at the Cup Championship Party.

Q: What do I do if I am injured on the course?

A: There will be ambulance and bike EMS teams providing medical support courtesy of Houston Methodist Orthopedics and Sports Medicine along the course to attend to injuries.

Q: Will there be food at the finish line?

A: Yes, there will be food at the finish line provided by the event producer.

Q: Is the course closed to traffic?

A: Yes, one lane will be closed for runners. Lanes will be coned off throughout the race for runners' safety.

Q: Is the course USA Track and Field Sanctioned?

A: Yes, the event USA Track and Field sanctioned event. The course was measured and is pending USA Track and Field certification.

The Lone Star Flag Park



The **Lone Star Monument and Historical Flag Park** celebrates Texas history with 13 battle flags that flew as Texas won her independence. The outdoor museum also features a 14 foot bronze statue of a common Texas Revolution era soldier known as "The Texian".

National & State Forests



The **Sam Houston National Forest** borders Lake Conroe and is home to the **Lone Star Hiking Trail**, a trail that expands over 128 miles. The **W. Goodrich Jones State Forest**'s nature trail, picnic tables, horseback riding, and fishing make it a perfect outdoor destination. Both are fantastic for birding year round.
