The Cause – Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS)

Amytrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS) is a neuromuscular disease that attacks the brain and spinal cord. There is no cure and the average life span after diagnosis is 2-5 years. ALS takes away the ability to move, speak, swallow, and ultimately breathe - and it can strike anyone.

There are currently 30,000 people in the United States living with ALS and someone in the world is diagnosed every 90 seconds. Without raising awareness and funding, ALS will not receive the research necessary to find a cure, and will continue to strike down every person who is diagnosed.

The Race

The Fiesta 5k Challenge brings entire families out for a morning of health & fitness, awareness for ALS, community outreach, and a celebration of life. Since 2007 the race has raised over \$250,000 for the Emory ALS Center. The race takes place at Fowler Park in Cumming, GA.

We are on a mission to stop ALS so come run LOCO with us at our 11th annual race benefiting the Emory ALS Center. 5k runners/walkers will love the beautiful Big Creek Greenway course – a 12 foot wide concrete and boardwalk path winging through the woods along Big Creek. It is flat and fast! The Fun Run takes place on the track at Fowler Park.

The Organization – Cure for ALS

Our family – Mike, Karen, Brian, and Kevin – are known to many as "Team Duffy". We have been involved in triathlons since 2001 when Brian started racing at the age of seven. After watching a broadcast of the 2005 Ironman World Championship, Brian was motivated to help raise awareness and money to find a cure for ALS. He was inspired by Jon Blais, one of the athletes who finished the race that day – Jon had been diagnosed with ALS just five months prior.

Brian started, and what has now become, a family mission to end ALS. In 2006, his first fundraising campaign involved writing letters to get family and friends to gain sponsors for his triathlons. Since then, Brian had an idea to host a community road race because he knew it would raise significant dollars to donate toward ALS research. We formed the nonprofit organization, Cure for ALS, and developed this annual event. The inaugural race was held in 2007 and it has grown each year since. We've since added an annual golf tournament each fall, partnering with former Atlanta Falcon Terance Mathis. All proceeds from Cure for ALS events benefit the Emory ALS Center. We have helped to raise \$500,000.
