

FAQ Ohiopyle Half Marathon, 5K & 10K

Is a mask required when not running?

- No, you do not have to wear a mask while running, but we do require a mask in the registration pickup area and the finish line as there may be a crowd of people.
- They are also required inside buildings including, but not limited to restrooms at the park.

What is required for check-in?

- Please have a copy (paper or open on your phone) of your QR code from registration.
- You received this code in the runner detail email sent on 5.11.2021 as well as when you registered.

I'm running the challenge, do I use the same bib for all three races?

- Yes, it is the same bib. So you will not need to check in again on Sunday for the half, you can go right to the start line anytime between 6:30 and 7:30am.

What time can I pick up my bib Saturday morning?

- Saturday —
Pickup will begin at 6:30 AM for the 5k Runners and challengers at the parking area.
Pickup will begin at 8:00 AM for the 10K Runners at the parking area.
Half Marathon Runners can pick up for the Sunday event after the 10K starts (after 9AM).
- Sunday —
Pickup will begin at 6:30 AM at the parking area.

Is there an awards ceremony?

- There will not be a formal ceremony.
- It is the responsibility of the runner to check their results (the link will be emailed as well as posted in Facebook on the event page and in runsignup) and then go to the award table to pick up their award from the staff member there on race day.

- There are event medals for each race as well as an additional medal for challengers. Please remember to grab your medal from the table if there is not a person handing them out. This will be at the finish line. We can't mail medals after the event.
- Awards will be available after the following times:
5k-after 8:30am,
10k-after 10:00am
Half marathon-after 9:30am on Sunday

Is there food after the races?

- There will be burritos or some type of hot food provided by the local Falls Market on both days.

Can spectators be at the start/finish line?

- The park is open to the public so anyone is allowed to be in the park.
- Please do not gather around the start/finish area where runners are crossing the line or any of the food areas.
